Introduction

Describing the term "Deen"

Deen and its Importance

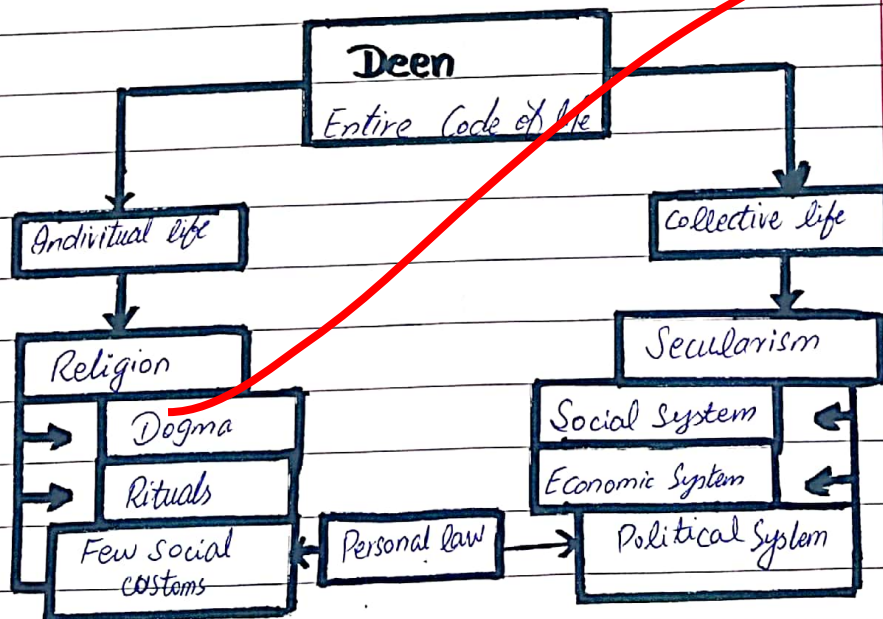
Deen is a major term which refers to destination while Religion is a pathway which leads towards destination (Deen).

(AL-Imran)

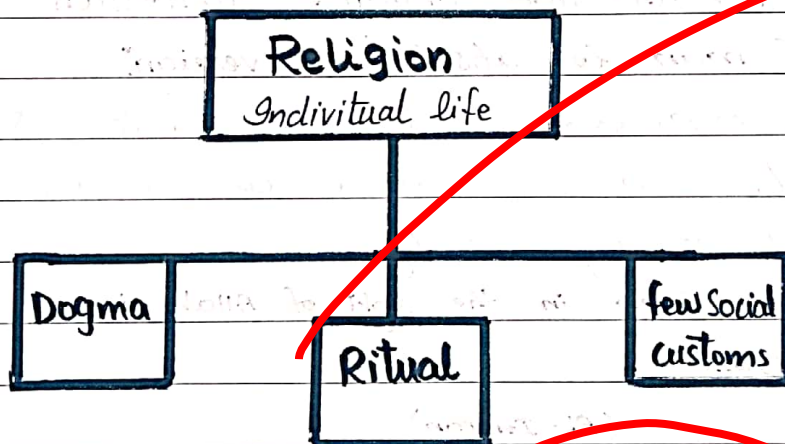


Religion and its Scope
