

## Topic : Education problems

There are several challenges in the education system of Pakistan but allocation of low budget to education is the most significant challenge.

Because low budget allocation means lack of financial resources for education which create several problems like lack of infrastructure development, no water, no classrooms and no access to electricity etc. Allocation of low budget also shows that politicians and policymakers are not interested to promote education and enhance education quality. It shows that education is not the priority of government and policymakers. According to Economic Survey of Pakistan 2022-23, only 1.7% of GDP is spent on Edu education in 2022, which shows that how much our policymakers give importance to education. If we compared this figure with our neighbouring countries like India and China which spend 4.5% and 3.6% <sup>of GDP</sup> in 2020 respectively,



according to World Bank. This shows that low allocation of budget to education in Pakistan is the most significant problem of education system of Pakistan.
