Moreover, US also signed a deal of trade through US-Indo Pacific partnership.

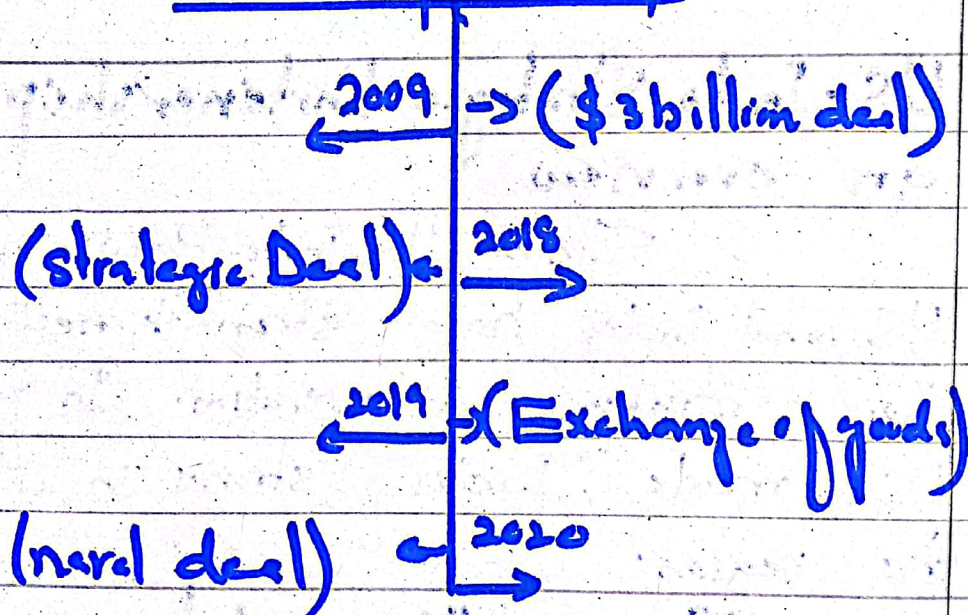

c) Quad: US-India Partnership

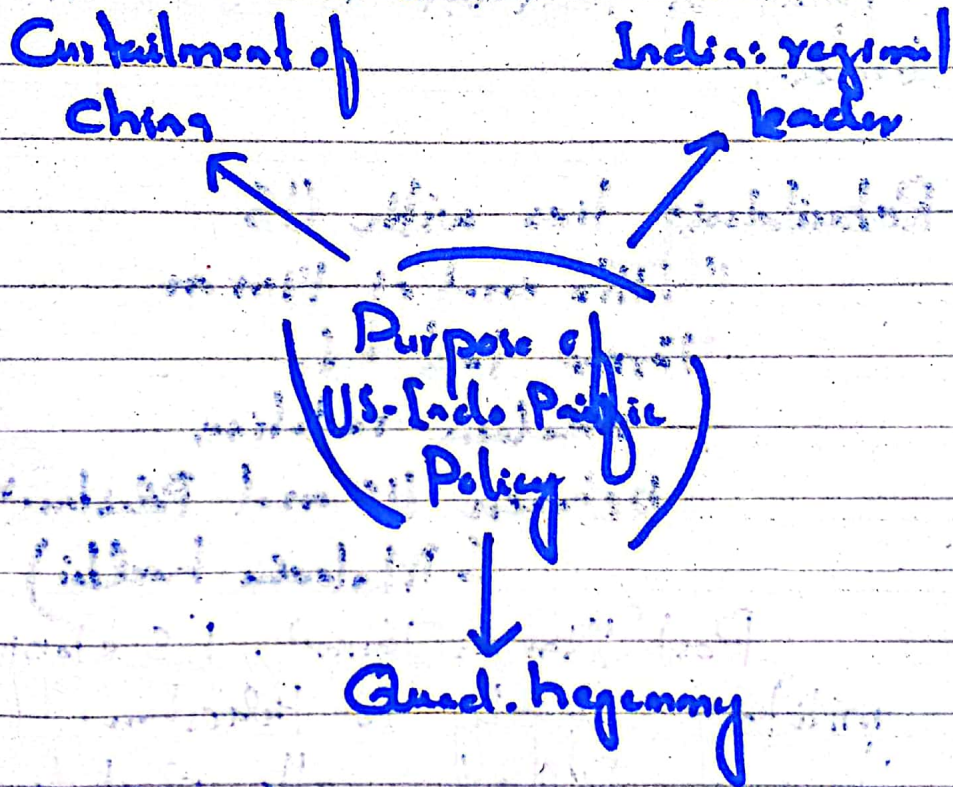

Therefore, Pakistan is attempting to rebuild ties with the US.

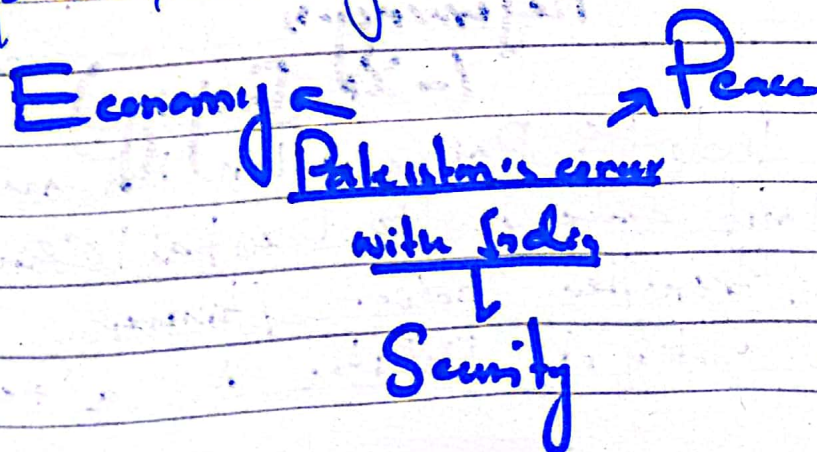
b) Improving relations with its neighbour: India
