- 4.6) Lack of political support to feminism and political will to implement pro-women laws.
- 4.7) Dearth of ~~that~~ awareness and gender sensitization has made society ^{too} sexist to understand feminism.

5) What are the impacts of not comprehending the idea of feminism in our society?

- 5.1) Women will be more vulnerable to gender stereotyping, marginalization and gender based violence.
