

## Social and Cultural Problems of a Society.

Both cultural and social problems are interlinked. Culture has two aspects; an external formal and an inner ideological.

Both aspects are part of a social structure and both are interconnected. Cultural problems are not solved in ~~isolation~~ from social problems. Cultural problems of underdeveloped countries are thus solved on the same basis. The problems of the countries were due to European colonist rule over them for a long period. Some of these countries were developed feudal societies while others were developing tribal societies. Both these societies got engaged in rivalry among themselves and national groups and among different classes of the same group. The colonist rule further enhanced this fragmentation. So the structure is a divided one in liberated countries given to them by the colonist rule.
