

**Ques 1** What is the difference between Deen and Religion? Describe the importance of Deen in human life with arguments. (CSS - 2016)

## 1) Introduction:-

Islam covers all-aspects of life; therefore, it is a deen. Although many scholars have argued that there is not a wider difference between 'deen' and 'religion', most of the Islamic scholars believed that deen is a broader term while religion is a sub-set of the deen. The common differences between deen and religion are: universalism and particularism.

The Deen provides guidance in individual and collective sphere of life whereas religion only covers spiritual life of an individual. Thereby, deen plays a vital role in human life. For instance, deen provides spiritual nourishment, protects women and weaker communities' rights, ensures justice in a society, and provides guidance for a purposeful life. So, Islam is a deen with a complete system and way of life.


## 2) Decoding Deen or Lexicology of Deen

Deen is an Arabic word which means way, obedience, judgement, and accountability. Deen is a way of life which covers all needs of an individual.

### According to the Oxford dictionary:-

Deen is a broader term which covers all aspects of life including spiritual, moral, political, economical and social spheres.





### 3) Religion Lexicology

The term ~~be~~ Religion is derived from Italian "Religore" which means to bind, "tie back", "bind to" shows an individual relation with God or gods.

Religion is a belief in god or gods for worship and follow particular rituals and dogmas.

### 4) what is Islam: A religion or a deen

Islam is complete way of life which covers spiritual, moral, political, economic, social spheres of life.

Therefore, Islam is ~~a~~ deen. In Quran, Allah referred Islam as deen not a religion.

**Dr Tsoar Ahmed** called Islam a comprehensive system which include political, economical, and social system; therefore, Islam is a deen.

**Dr Jaffer Dureshi** :- Dr concluded in his book Islamic concept of deen and its relevance today that Religion refers to a particular set of beliefs whereas Deen is broader term which covers all aspects of human life. So, Islam is a complete way of life; therefore, it is not a religion but a deen.

## 5. Difference between Religion and Deen:-

### 5.1) Universal vs Particular

Deen is a universal while religion is particular. Deen covers all subjects of life, on the other hand, religion only provides guidance in spiritual life. Thereby, Islam is a deen because Islam provides guidance to the whole mankind. Allah mentioned in the Holy Quran : "O Muhammad! "we have sent you as a mercy for whole mankind" (Al-Anbiya). Thus, Deen is a universal while religion is a particular subject.

### 5.2) Provides guidance in individual and collective life while religion covers spiritual life

Deen not only provides guidance in individual development but also assists in <sup>collective</sup> society development. In Islam, for instance, Family laws, Inheritance laws,

political and economic system guide humans in collective spheres of life. On the other hand, religion only covers individual relations with his or her gods.

**5.3) Deen provides harmony between material world and divine world while religion focuses on divine world:-**

Deen provides harmony between material world and divine world. It encourages an individual to participate in worldly Affairs. In Islamic economic system, Muslims are encouraged to participate in business and there is no restriction on profit making if profit business is conducted on fair and just terms. (on the contrary) Allah mentions in the Quran "Our Lord! Provide us in this world (that is better for us) and in the hereafter (that is better for us) and protect us from the hell of fire".

On the contrary, Religion emphasizes on spiritual matter and denounce worldly Affairs.

**5.4) Deen challenges fatalism and Religion promotes fatalism:-**

Deen denounce fatalism and encourage an individual to seek guidance from the Holy Quran, and the Sunnah and utilize intellect to solve complex matters of life. On the other hand, religion promotes fatalism by arguing that every thing comes from the god and humans have no role in deciding their matters.

## 5.5) Monotheist vs Polytheist

Deen, as Islam, is believed in Monotheism which is unity of Allah or God. On the contrary, religions like Hinduism, Buddhism, are believed in polytheism which is believed in plurality of gods. In Islam, there is strong focus on Tawhid concept which said "اللهُ أَكْبَرُ" (Allah is the greatest) there is only one God which is Allah. So, Deen emphasizes on unity of God while religion emphasizes on plurality of gods.

## 6) Importance of Deen in human life :-

### 6.1) Provides guidance for a purposeful life.

Deen provides guidance for a purposeful life. It assists an individual in spiritual and worldly life. Holy

Prophet was not only successful in the religious life, but he was also highly successful in his secular life. (Michael H. Hart) (The 100 :

A Ranking of the Most Influential Persons in the World). So, Deen assists in all spheres of life.

### 6.2) Spiritual Nourishment.

Deen enhances spiritual nourishment through prayers, Taqwa, and remembrance of God. (Attachment) Holy

Prophet mentioned that "The likeness of the one who believed in God or the one who does not believe in God is like that of a living or a dead".

So, Deen strengthens spiritual power of an individual.



### 6.3 Provide protection to the weaker community in a society.

Deen provides protection to the weaker community in a society by commanding stronger to fulfill its rights. For instance, Allah ordered in Quran "Provide orphans their due share when they reach maturity." (An-Nisa). In short, Deen ensures complete protection of the weaker community.

### 6.4) Ensure justice in a society :-

Islam has provided strong emphasis on justice in a society. Allah mentions in the Quran that "Do not let the hatred of the people prevent you from being just" (Al-Hujurat). Hence, Justice system is a crucial component of an Islamic system.

### 6.5) Protection of women rights:-

Islam provided multiple women rights and believed in women empowerment. In the Quran Allah has ordered the main "إذْ أَنْتُمْ تُنكِحُونَ نِسَاءً" وَاتُوْزِعُنَّ " "Give women (you marry) their due dowries graciously" (Al-Nisa). Thus, Islam emphasizes on a women empowerment and provides protection to women rights.

Define Tauheed: what is its impact on individual life and the society?.

### 1) Introduction:-

Tauheed is a basic fundamental block in the fold of Islam. Without accepting tauheed with heart, no one can enter in the fold of Islam.

It is the strong belief in unity of Allah which makes a Muslim distinct from other people.

It has multiple impacts on individual and collective life of a human. For instance, Tauheed promotes patience and perseverance, induces humility and modesty, implants honesty and courageousness among individuals. Similarly, Tauheed also plays significant role at social level. For instance, It promotes equality, brotherhood, knowledge, and social justice in a society. Thus, Tauheed is a fundamental block in the characteristic in the Islamic teachings.

### 2) Meaning of Tauheed :-

The Islamic credo "La illah illah Allah" is a declaration that there is no other god except Allah.

**Dr Israr Ahmed :-** Dr Israr Ahmed said that- Tauheed is the basic belief which distinguish between Muslim and non-muslim. He believe that if a person belief in a Tauheed then he is a Muslim.



### 3) Importance of Tauheed in the light of Quran :-

"o People! worship Allah you do not have other god except him " (Hud)

Above Quranic verses show the importance of Tauheed in Islam. Allah and his prophet Muhammad (PBUH)

emphasized on the teachings of ~~of~~ Tauheed. It plays a significant role in the life of a Muslim.

### 4) Kinds of Tauheed

#### 4.1) Tauheed - ul - Rubbiyyah:-

Tauheed - ul - Rubbiyyah is the belief in the lordship of Allah. It is a belief that Allah is the one in his Lordship. There is no partner of Allah. He is the omnipresent, omnipotent and most powerful in the universe. Allah said in the Quran **وَاللَّهُ أَكْلَمُ الْأَنْجَلَيْنَ**

**" Your God is only one God "**. Islam rejected the Trinity ideas of Christian and emphasizes on the unity of Allah.



## 4.2) Tauheed - wiggah:-

Tauheed-wiggah is belief in the oneness of the worship of Allah. It signifies that only Allah is the capable of worship. Allah described in Quran, "I am God and there is no other God" (Taha). Thus, Allah is the only God who is capable of worship.

## 4.3) Tauheed al-Asma wa Al-sifat:-

It is a belief in the oneness of the names and attributes of Allah. Allah is unique in his attributes and names. "Allah is the creator of all things and he is the guardian and disposer of all affairs" (Az-Zumar). In short, Allah is the unique in his attributes and names.

## 5) Impacts of Tauheed on individual life

### 5.1) Promotes Patience and Preservurance:

Tauheed promotes patience and preservurance among an individual. It induces remembrance of Allah that everything comes from him and he is the only one who can help provide to an individual. Allah described in the Holy Quran "Be patient, surely Allah promise is true and let not disbeliever shaken your firmness" (Ay-Rum)

## 5.2) Promote Humility and modesty :-

Tauheed provides humility and modesty among an individuals' when an individual perform prayer then it will increase its humility owing to prostrate. It will decrease his ego and promote a sense of modesty.

## 5.3) Ensures justice in ~~in~~ personal dealings

Islam emphasizes justice on individual and society level. It believes that without justice peace can't be achieved in a society. "Do not let hatred of people prevent you from being just" (Al-Maidah)

## 5.4) ~~(Honesty and Trustworthiness)~~ Forgiveness and Mercy :-

Tauheed also implants forgiveness ~~habits~~ among individual. Holy Prophet <sup>(PBUH)</sup> is a best example for the Muslims who never hurt anyone and always forgives his adversaries. He said "The merciful person will receive mercy from the most merciful". So, Forgiveness is implanted among the Muslims.

## 5.5) Enhance courage among an individual:

Tauheed also enhances courage among Muslims because they know that there is only one God. Therefore, they will not prostrate before any person or god. They will only bear from one God which is Allah.



## 6) Tauheed impacts on collective life

### 6.1) Ensures social welfare in a society :-

Tauheed induces a self-responsibility towards society. It incalcul-

- Moreover, zakat-system in Islam plays a significant role in the welfare of a society. Allah has made zakat a compulsory act "Be steady fast in your prayers and pay zakat" (Al-Baqarah). In short, Tauheed ensures social development of a community.

### 6.2) Promotes Brotherhood:

Tauheed also promotes brotherhood in a society. It is because Holy prophet (PBUH) emphasized on Islamic unity. He made Ansars and Muhajir brothers with another. He also said that Muslim is a like a building block structure if one is affected, it will affect another. Thus, Tauheed promotes brotherhood in society.

### 6.3) Equality in a society :-

Tauheed also promotes equality in a society. Islam discouraged inequality on the basis of the racism, case, social status and religion. Holy prophet (PBUH) in his last sermon said that "No Arab is superior than non-Arab". In this regard, Islam is the only religion which emphasizes on promotes equality in a society.

#### 6.4) Promotes knowledge in a society.

Tauheed promotes knowledge and education in a society.

Islam supports education in all aspheres of life.

Holy Prophet (PBUH) promoted women education in the Arabian Peninsula. He said "seeking education is mandatory <sup>up</sup>on every Muslim" (Holy Prophet PBUH). So, Islam promotes rationality and reason in a society.

#### 6.5) Conclusion:-

To conclude, Tauheed is a basic fundamental belief of Islam. No person can enter in the fold of Islam, without accepting the concept of Tauheed.
