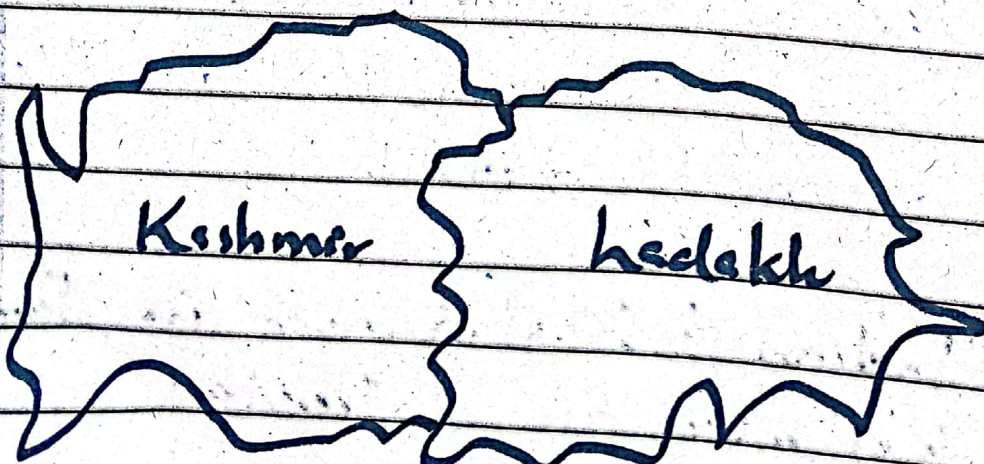
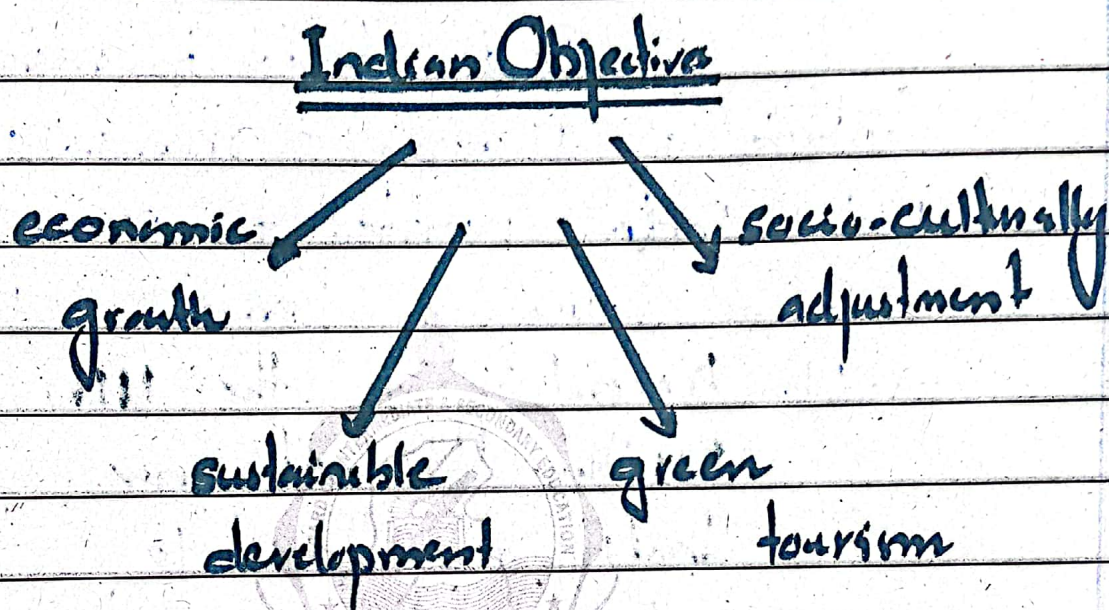

a) Economic growth at global level
