Online learning has several benefits, among which is it facilitates attention in education

along with job responsibilities. Many young in the world receives higher education along with their job performance. In Pakistan, almost young prefer online learning and also manages their job responsibilities, as well. According to a survey, "around 81.8 million young manages their higher education along with their job responsibility." (Labour Force Survey, 2022). Hence, online learning facilitates attention in education along with job responsibility.

Further, online learning encourages girls' education. In fact, girls in the world are mostly deprived of higher education. But, fortunately, online learning promotes girls' education through digital learning applications. As per report, "about 52 pc of

girls in Pakistan uses digital applications to receive higher education." (Hina Saleem, digital technology and education, 2023). Hence, online learning encourages girls' education.

Furthermore, digital learning promotes safe interaction in co-education form of education. Digital learning ensures safety of learning along with promotion of competitive co-education. In Pakistan, digital learning is regarded as a safe learning platform in co-education. According to a survey of 2021, "more than 57% of population considers online learning as a safe co-education." (Faraz Bano, survey conducting for co-education on digital welfare, 2021). Therefore, digital learning is a safe interaction of co-education learning.

Moreover, online learning

has encouraged housewives in higher education. In fact, online learning has removed almost barriers of learning and has encouraged education of housewives in the world, too. Pakistan also encourages education of housewives and provides several opportunities of digital learning. "Among higher officials, more than half of housewives are beneficiaries of digital education." (Toqeer Hussain, digital technology and housewife education, 2022). Thus, digital learning has also encourages education of housewives.

Besides these, digital learning has also emphasizes literacy rate through online education. In fact, literacy rate is increased due to enhancement of digital learning. Online learning has facilitated

education and an abrupt increase in literacy is observed in the few years. As per economic survey, "literacy rate is increased more than before after 2019 due to promotion of digital technology in education" (Zubaida Mustafa, education during covid-19, 2020). Therefore, online learning has also facilitated literacy rate.

Besides online learning, traditional classroom instructions are considered best platforms of learning. Attention is considered as an essence of traditional learning. Majority of people considers attention is only possible in traditional learning due to eyes of teacher's face to face. However, digital learning lacks such eyes of attention. According to a report, "about 37% of people think that traditional

classroom learning is a foundation of attentive learning." (Nada, global skills, 2023). Thus, traditional classroom is a home of attentive learning.

Moreover, traditional classroom learning encourages girls' mobility in education. In fact, girls' education is encouraged due to mobility in education platform. Several steps are taken to promote girls' education in traditional classroom participation in Pakistan. "The government of Sindh has introduced women's exclusive buses in Karachi to promote traditional classroom participation of girls" (Hina Saleem, Women's mobility, 2023). Therefore, traditional classroom potential has encouraged girls' physical learning of education.

Further, ^{legis} in online learning declares
potential of digital learning
and encourage traditional
learning form of education.
Due to digital technological advance-
ment, misuses are also enhanced
by students in digital learning.
Resultantly, it affects online
form of education especially
in Pakistan. According to a

report, "Pakistan rural
society is scared of digital
technology in education promotion
due to ^{measure of technological}
advancement." (Saima Khatun,
fear of technology, 2021).

Therefore, misuse of technology
in digital learning promote
traditional learning.

Furthermore, household
responsibilities of housewives in
education learning poses way
of obstacles in digital
learning. Almost housewives feel

difficulty in managing online education along with their household responsibilities. Consequently, household responsibilities lead to hurdles in online learning.

According to a report, (almost 0.6 pc of) 10 pc women feel difficulty in managing online learning along with their household responsibilities. (Faizal Bin, life style recalibration, 2023). Thus, household responsibilities make an obstacle in online learning.

Meanwhile, traditional classroom is considered as a real image of literacy rate. Most of people consider online learning mere a source of paper & degree, but, traditional learning a true image of literacy rate. Almost in every job opportunity, form of education is preferred. more and more opportunities are provided.

to the best institutions of traditional learning. Therefore, traditional learning is regarded as a real mirror of literacy rate.

Despite above statements, online learning is a priority of learning today. As online learning has an evidence of solid attentive learning than traditional classroom learning. In fact, online learning is only a platform of attentive learning away from traditional disruption learning. According to UNDP Report, "about 60% of students are rushing to receive online learning for the sake of attentive learning." (Global Basic Learning Education 2021). Therefore, online learning is an attentive learning platform besides disruption of traditional learning.

Moreover, online learning promotes a begin of learning of girls' education. Due to several cases of girls' harassment and insecurity, online learning has provided girls' safe education at their homes. Not only this, but online learning has strengthened future planning of education making them brave through online instructions and digital awareness. According to the World Economic Forum, "online education has further enhanced girls' safe education in Pakistan." (the World Economic Forum, 2021). Therefore, online learning is the first home of girls' education.

Further, misuse of technology is a blame on digital learning. However, misuse of co-ordination in co-education on traditi-

onal learning affects traditional education, while online education is not affected by misuse of technology. In fact, use of technology in education leads to education and promotes educational society. Therefore, traditional classroom is more affected by mis-co-operation among co-education than online learning.

Furthermore, household obstacles are also blamed as hurdles in online learning. In fact, online learning convenient household responsibilities along with higher digital learning. Online learning is beneficial even in household responsibilities. A survey indicates that housewives manages their online education in a better way than in a traditional classroom learning as traditional classroom learning consumes their more

time. Therefore, online learning is not affected by household responsibilities in education of a housewife.

The last but not the least, online learning is encouraged more today to increase literacy rate. In fact several hurdles are obvious in traditional classroom instructions. But, online learning provides all facilities of a true education and hence, it is appreciated across the country. "The government of Sindh has introduced a digital application in public schools for bringing out-of-school students in order to enhance educated society." (Transforming education, Pakistan social standards and Measurement Survey, 2023). Therefore, online education is encouraged to increase literacy rate.

To sum up, online education is more convenient and effective. In fact online education promotes attentive learning, encourages girls' education, provides safe learning platform. Not only this, but online education also encourages education of house wives. Moreover, online education learning increases literacy rate. This is all due to convenient learning of digital technology in education. However, traditional classroom is still considered as the learning platform and beneficial than online learning. But, fortunately, the global ideas promotes and encourages online learning. Therefore, online learning is more convenient and effective learning platform than traditional classroom learning.
