Ans: ① Introduction

Before suggesting the measures of controlling robberies and urban street criminality in Pakistan, one must understand the factors behind the increasing dacoities and urban street criminality in Pakistan by aligning the criminological theories. There are various ways forward to control the above mentioned menace in Pakistan, in the light of criminology. As like, strengthening the writ of State, creation of general deterrence, poverty alleviation, employment generation, application of social control theory and also by increasing Police mobility in red zone areas.

② Understanding the reasons behind the robberies and Urban street criminality in Pakistan in the light of criminological theories.

③ Social Disorganization Theory: A depiction of Urban street crime

The social disorganization theory of criminology suggests that, there are three main factors

behind these crimes, number one is the excessive poverty and number second is the cultural heterogeneity and rapid mobilisation. To understand this theory one must understand its basic terminology. As, the excessive poverty creates no options for the people but the only come: money to service. Similarly, the cultural heterogeneity in the urban cities give freedoms to children from the community guidance and the rapid mobilisation also increase the socialisation of youths with different people. In the context of social disorganisation theory, it can be seen that in the urban cities of Pakistan the cultural heterogeneity is common, excessive poverty is prevailing in the slum areas of urban cities and also rapid mobilisation is common.

⑥ Anomic Theory : A depiction of robbery during social upheaval

Anomic theory suggests that during the social upheavels like disasters, revolutions or war the writ of the state becomes weak and people stops to follow the law. That increases the crimes. In this context it can be seen that, during the floods

of area in Pakistan the cases of robbery increased by 10% because of social upheaval.


② Social Learning Theory; A way of learning for youths

The Social Learning theory suggests that the people in a society learns from their surrounding environment. For example, as kid learns from parents, follows the favorite actors and also follows the peers. In the context of Social Learning theory, the youth of Pakistan also gets motivated from the uncensored material from the social media.

③ Strain Theory; A highlighter of Blue collar crimes in Pakistan

The strain theory proposed the idea that, the crime or deviance behaviour of somebody is due to the some deprivation in his past, because of economic or sociological factor. That strain kept the individual in frustration and motivated towards the crime. In the light of strain theory, the

② Measures to control robbery / dacoiti and urban street criminality in Pakistan

① Strengthening the writ of State

⑥ Police Mobility and Surveillance in the Red Alert areas
