Both cultural and social problems are interlinked. Culture has two aspects; an external formal and an inner ideological. Both aspects are part of a social structure and both are interconnected. Cultural problems are not solved in isolation from social problems. Cultural problems of underdeveloped countries are thus solved on the same basis. The problems of the countries were due to European colonist ^{who} ruled over them for a long period. Some of these countries were developed feudal societies while others were developing tribal societies. Both these societies got engaged in rivalry among themselves and national groups and among different classes of the same group. The colonist rule further enhanced this fragmentation.
