(- Ishtiaq Hussain)

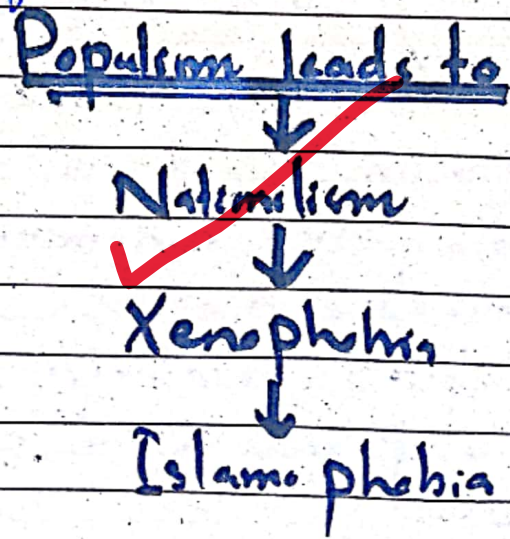


Further, many anti-Islamic populist leads ideology of Islamophobia. In fact, their populism promotes Islamophobia.
