Negative Effects of Global Warming & Climate Change

Environmental Effects:-

Increased breakdown of ice cover: Due to global warming, there is increased melting of ice glaciers across the globe. As per International conference on Ice and snow African glaciers are shrunked by 82%, China glaciers by 25%, Russia glaciers by 50%. As per NASA, Himalayan glaciers are among the most fastest melting glaciers in the world. Shigal, Bhatura and Siachin glaciers are facing severe ice melting.

Due to increased melting of ice cover,

there is 8 inches level rise in the sea level.

Increased intensity and frequency of disasters

Due to climate change, there is increased intensity of flooding. As per NDMA there is 1500 deaths in the floods of 2022 and 45 deaths in floods of Karachi 2020.

Due to intense flooding there is increased damage to infrastructure.

2. Social effects:-

Due to increased disasters, there is great effect on poverty, inflation, employment etc.

There is increased threat to the human life due to increased heatwaves due to global warming. Almost 1500

have died in Karachi due to heatwaves in the last 4 years. People living

3. Economic Effects:

Due to disasters like flooding as a result of global warming, it cause a lot of economic damage as well

As per NDMA, almost 5000km of roads ~~are~~ and 500 bridges are damaged in 2022 floods. and financial loss of \$16bn in 2022 floods.

Due to flooding and excessive heat waves, agricultural system of Pakistan is damaged. In 2022 due to heatwaves, almost 30-40% decrease in mango production which then lead to economic damage, food insecurity, poverty

4. Political effects:

Water is used on shared basis by all the countries. As Pakistan and India are sharing waters of Indus river through Indus water Treaty.

As ice is melting due to global warming, there will be shortage of water and conflicts will arise
