There are some remedies which are helpful to reduce the Juvenile delinguerry in Pakistans-1-Strengthening the Justice Systems Establishment of specialized courts for juvenile cases ensuring fair and Fast trials and implementing effective rehabilitation programs for juvenile offenders. 2- Social Welfare programs: Introducing programs that
provide support and oppositunities for
underprivileged youth, including access to
education, vocational training, the

employment opportunities.
