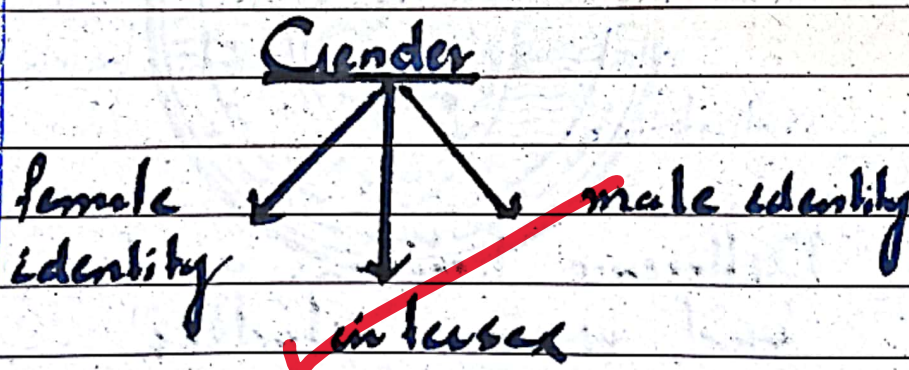

Origin of women studies comes from the feminist theory. The feminism work led to the foundation of women studies.

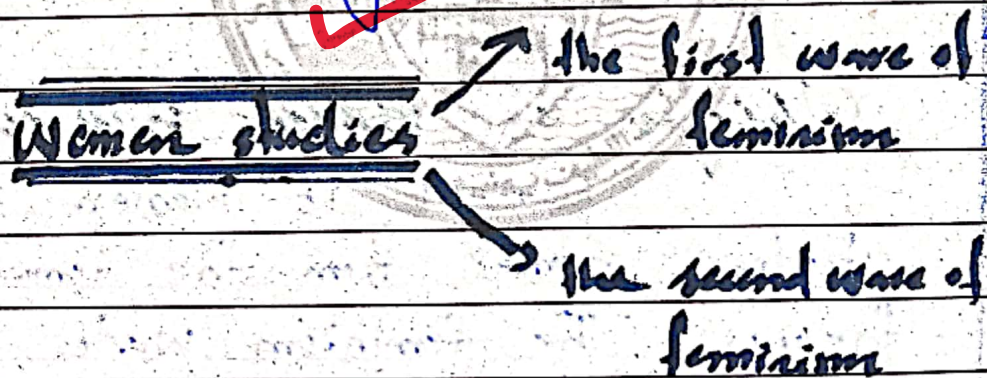
"feminist work is the root of women's rights, one must be a feminist to get rights of women."

However, gender studies is not only concerned with the problems of women studies but also respects to male and intersex problems. Therefore, gender studies is more inclusive.

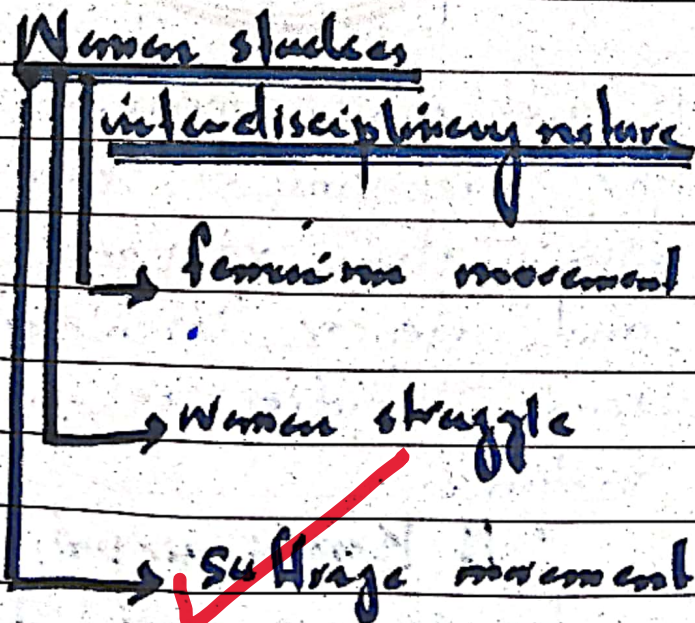

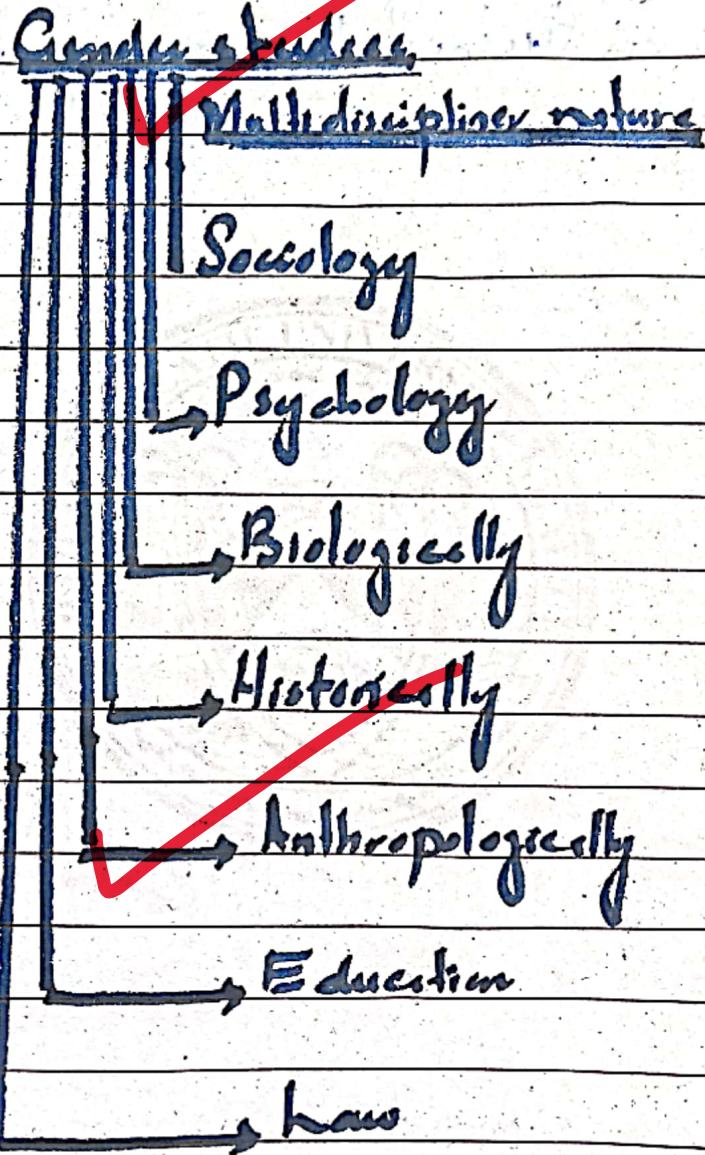
e) Nature of women studies
