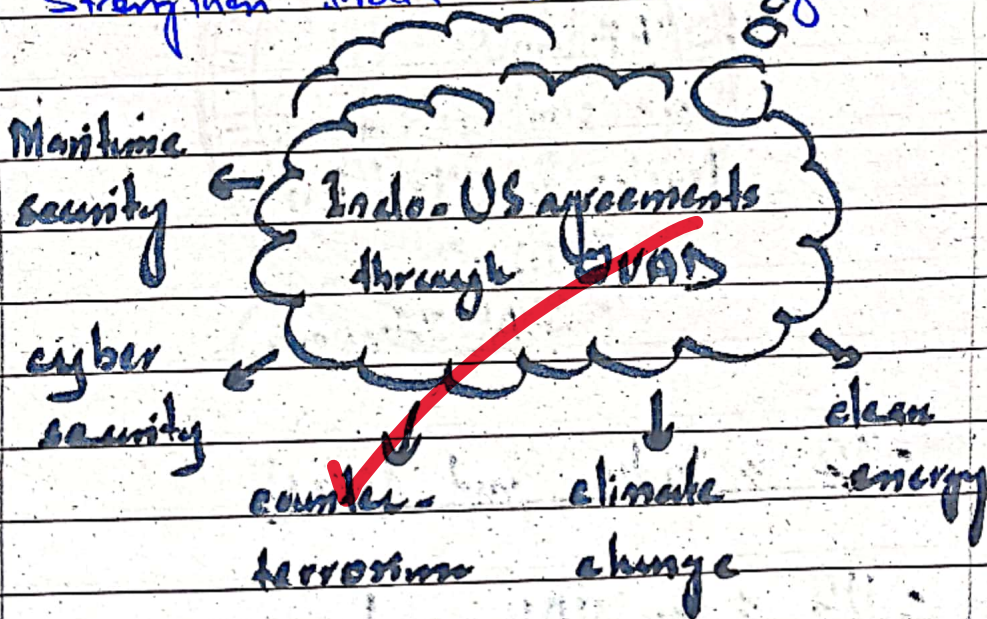
3. US-Indo Strategic Partnership beyond QUAD

c) Indo-US defence agreement - an overview

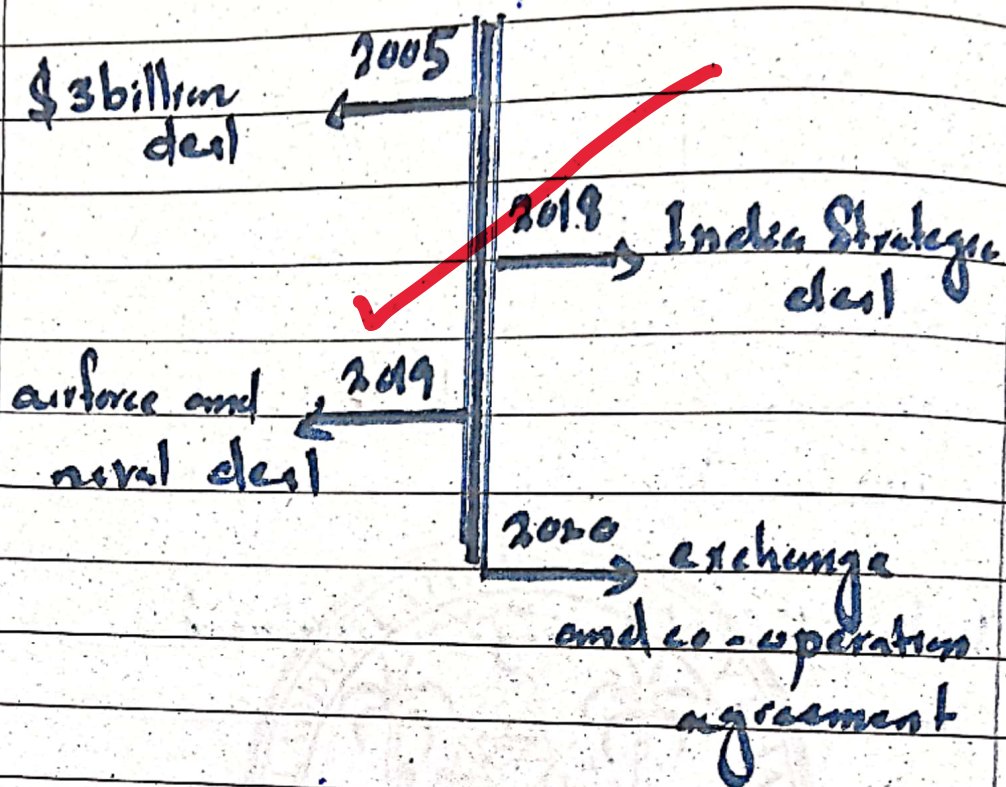
Further, the US-Indo defence agreements were increased. This new approach of agreements strengthen the Indo-US strategic partnership.

An overview of Indo-US defence deal

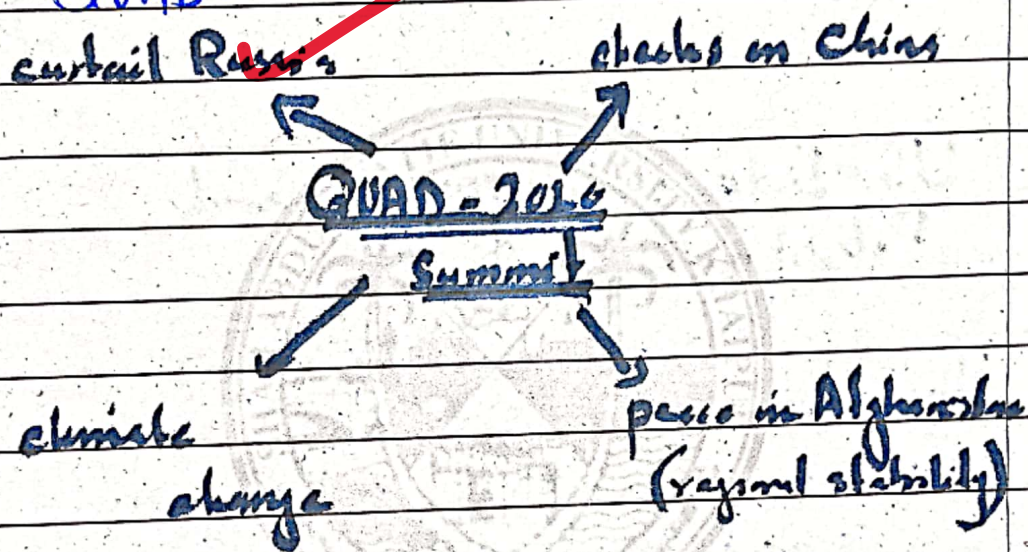


d) QUAD - Summit 2022 - a glimpse
