Centre of excellence
of women studies :-

The women studies centres in Pakistan can be divided into Public sectors and Private sectors. Public sectors are those which are being funded by govt institutions and private sectors are those which are usually funded by private institutions and international donors. The centre of excellence was emerged in Karachi university under the ministry of women developed and it started five years national action plan regarding gender studies and for the first time gender studies was introduced as a subject in 1989 in University of Karachi and in 1996, UOK started MA program in gender studies. And in 2002, women

studies programs spreaded to
Mphil and P.Hd level
in Karachi univerty.
And all this was due
to the efforts of
centre of excellence of
women studies.

Efforts of Pakistan association for women studies :-

The Pakistan women
association has been
working for women
issues since it's emer-
gence in 1991 - Currently
in Pakistan under the
supervision of Pakistan
association for women
studies, gender studies
and women studies
are flourishing swiftly
in universities of Pakistan.
Due to PAWS, various
universities started gender
studies and women studies
programs.

- In 1999, research centre for women studies was established in Fatima Jinnah women university.
