1973 constitution is become a successful constitution. In part, 18th amendment 2010, changed nature of 1973 constitution and improved bond between center and provinces. Thus, 1973 constitution under 18th amendment put soul in center province relations.

### 3. Center provinces relations under 18th amendment of 1973 constitution

Following discussion shows center province relation:

- a) Provincial autonomy granted
- Provincial autonomy granted under 18th amendment. Powers were divided between center and provinces. Before, 18th amendment, 3 federal lists were existing, but

after 18th amendment concurrent list was abolished and 36 subjects were given to provinces and 11 subjects were given to center.

"concurrent list abolishment shared major powers to provinces."  
(- Raza Rabbani)

Thus, provincial autonomy granted.

## b) Restricted Use of Emergency

Moreover, emergency use restricted. Before 18th amendment president had power, but, now:

- The Prime Minister will invoke emergency in the center with president consultation and approval of both houses is necessary."

(- Article 232)

Moreover,

"President will declare emergency in provinces with approval of provincial assembly"  
(- Article 234)

Therefore, 18th amendment shared power of emergency, too.

c) Improve center province relations

Further, center province relations are improved under 18th amendment. According to Article 153, 154, 155:

"Premier will appoint members with consultation of chief ministers of provinces."  
(- 18th Amendment)

Therefore, center province relations are improved.

d) Enhanced parliament form of government

Furthermore, 18th amen-

ment enhanced parliamentary form of government. In order to improve center province relations, parliamentary form of government enhanced.

"There will be power of premier in federal territory."

(- Article 90)

- AND -

"There will be power of PMs in federal courts."

(- Article 105)

Therefore, parliamentary form of government enhanced.

## e) The National Finance Commission (NFC) Award

Besides above, NFC

share formula was designed under 18th amendment.

According to 18th amendment, NFC share will be divided between center and provinces with respect to given formula.

## Formula of NFC share

Population	82.2pc
Poverty and backwardness	10.2pc
Revenue generation	4.2pc

Therefore, NFC share formula was designed.
