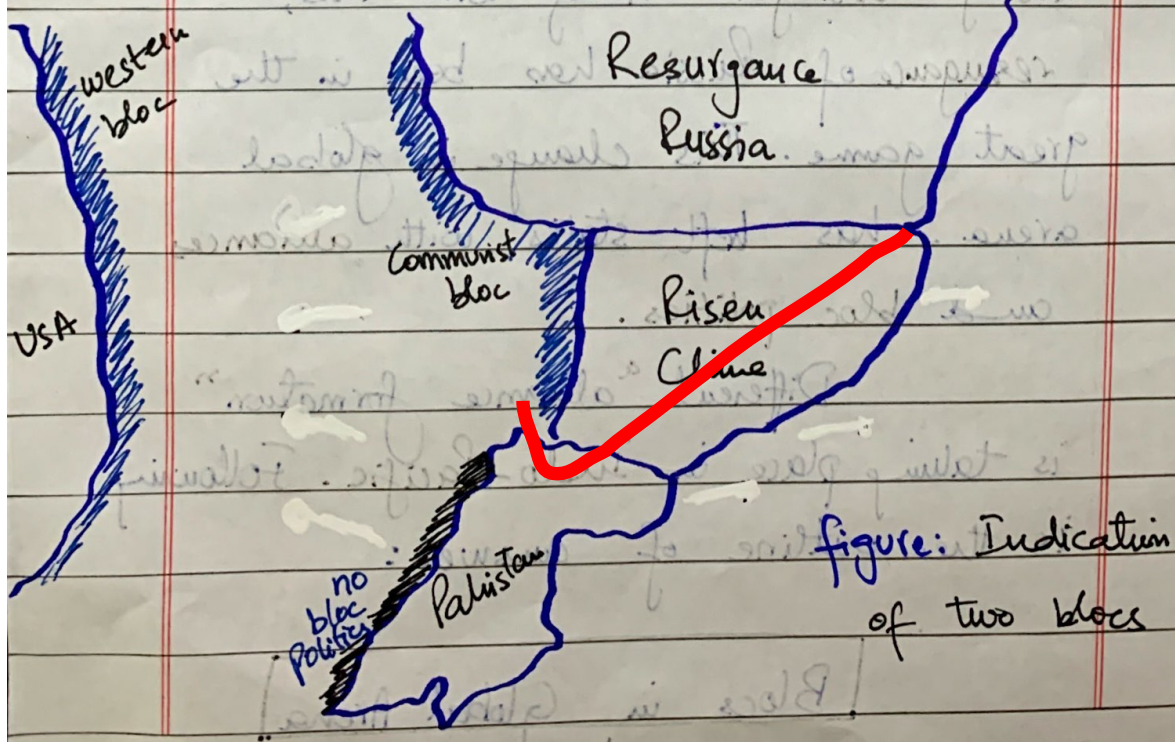

III- Global Politics and Domains of Alliance Formation: US-Sino Rivalry

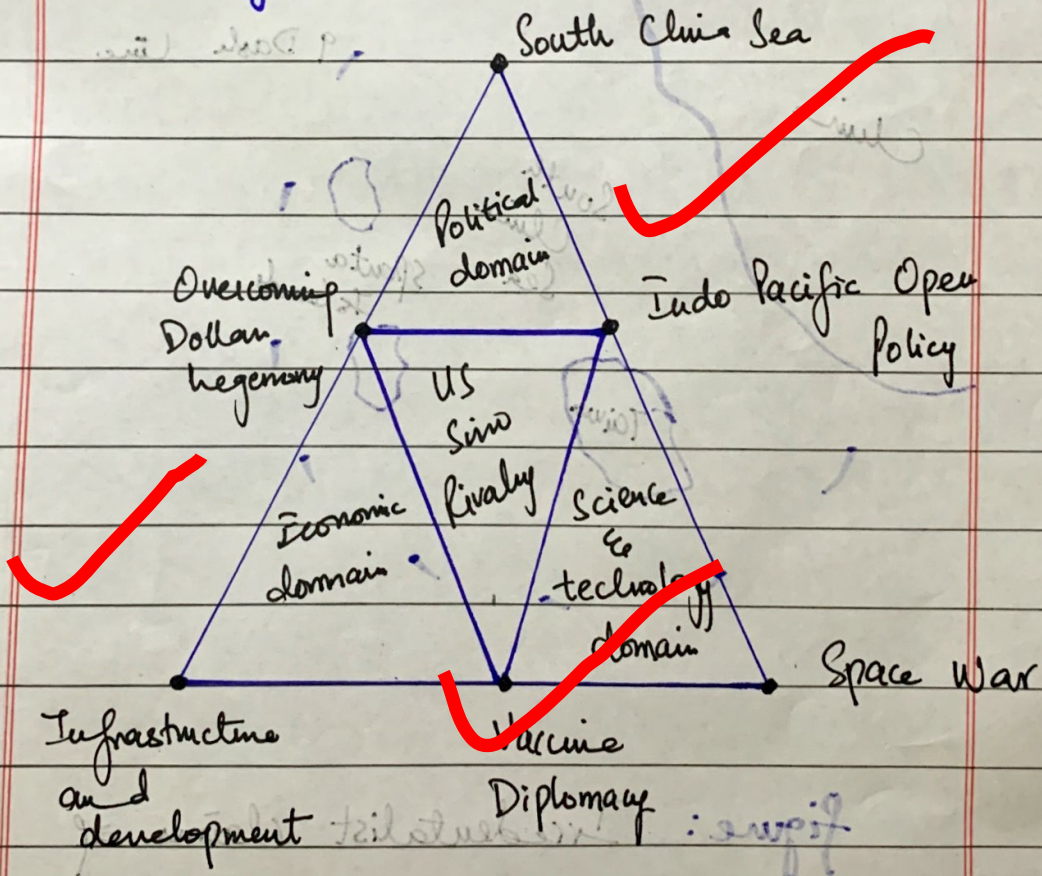


Figure: Different domains or battleground of US-China rivalry.

 China has irredentalist claims on South China Sea.

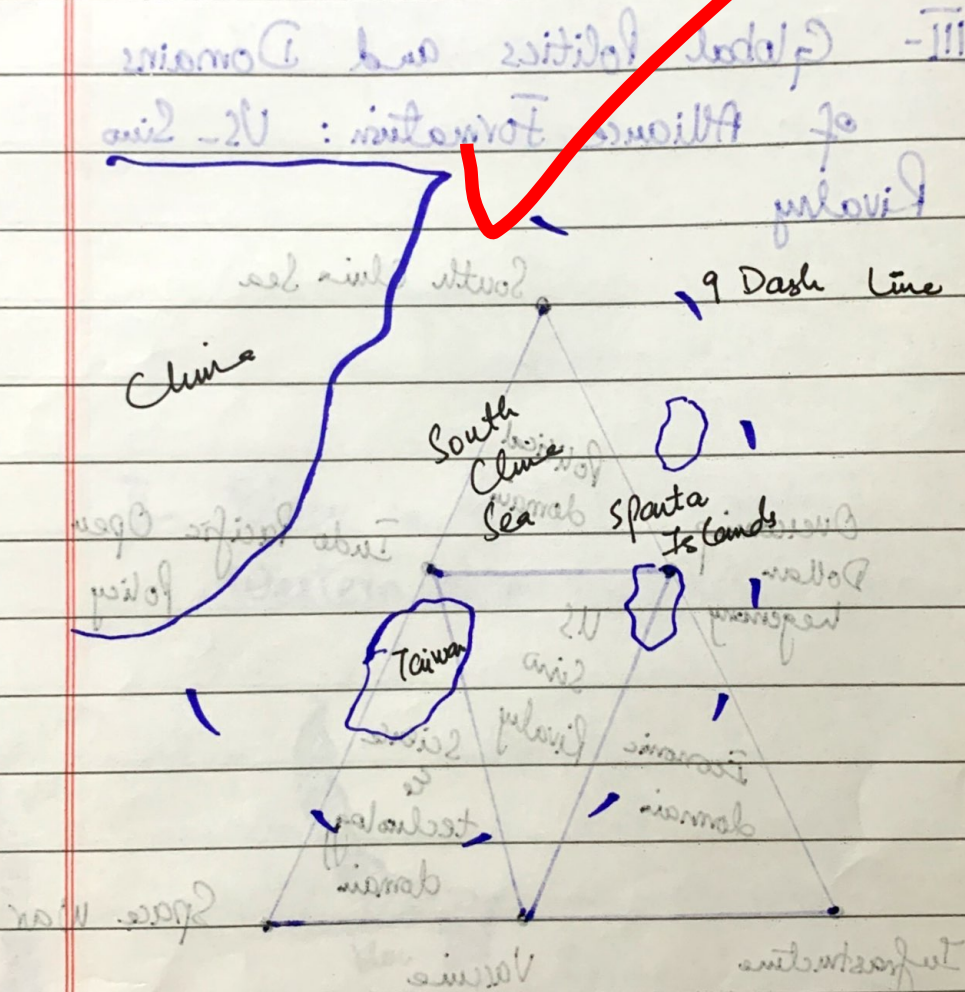


figure: Irredentalist claims of China.

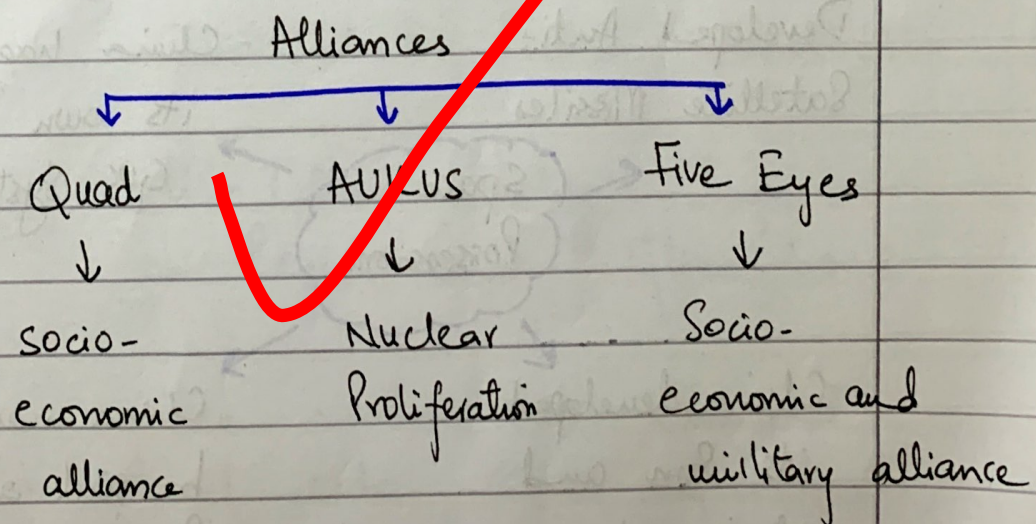
Phillipines has won the Award against China. Some part of South

Forbes reported that

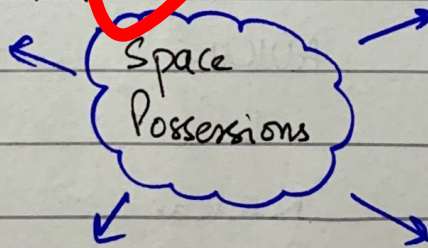

China has its own GPS System

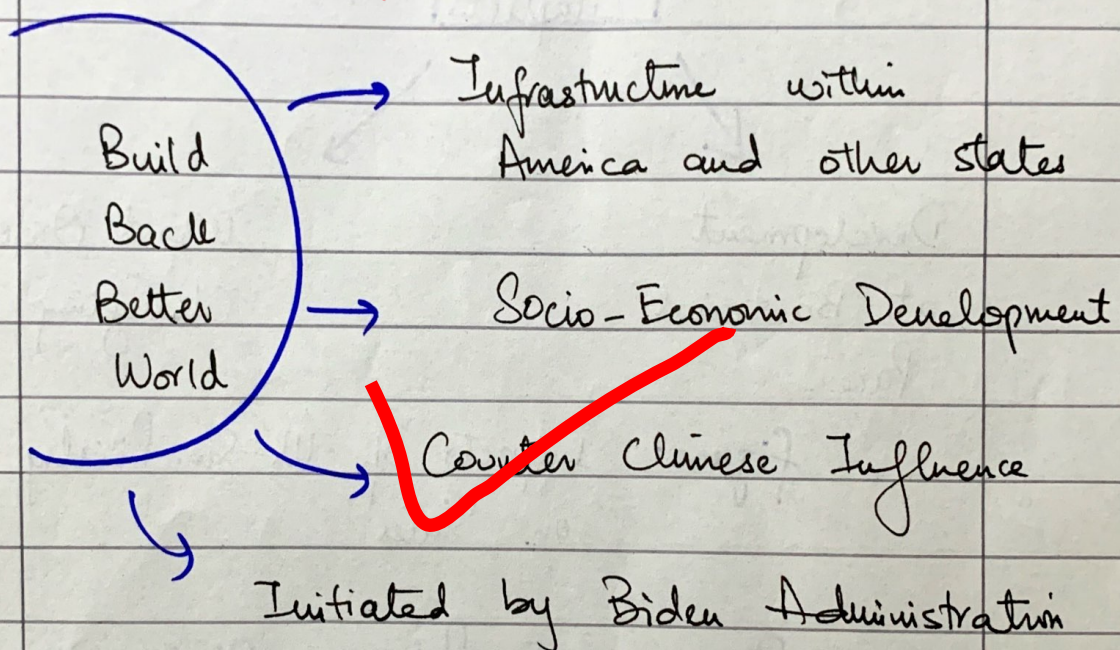


China developed its Sun and claims to have presence on Moon

To counter China's BRI, G8 summit, USA announced B3W.

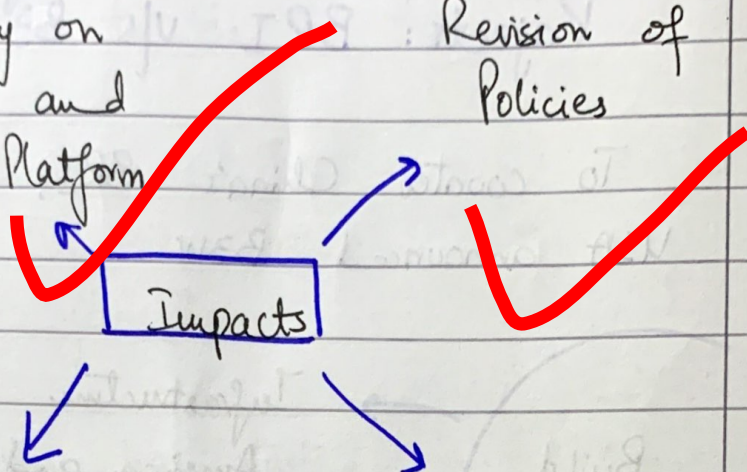


IV - US-China Rivalry: Impacts on Region and Global Level

figure: Impacts of US-Sino Rivalry on States

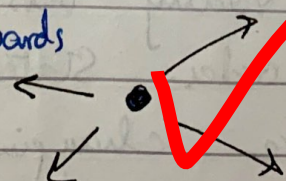
a- Revision of Policies: Shift of Foreign Policies in Previous Allies.

Pakistan-Turkey-Iran-Russia-China Nexus

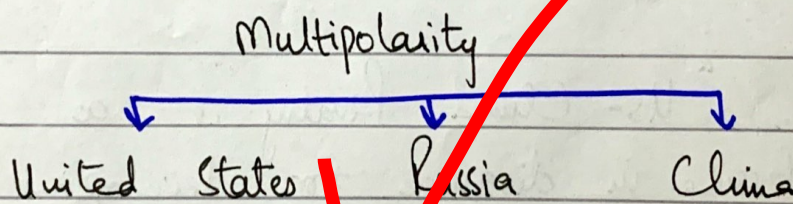
Russia-Iran-China axis
