⇒ My father has expressed his fear that I have caught cold again. ✗

⑥ His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend the meeting today."
Past Present

⇒ My brother told me that he ~~was~~ not going to attend the meeting that day. ✓

⑦ The inspector said to the people, "We have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon."
Present Past Future

⇒ The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to book soon. ✓

⑧ The lady ^{Past} has said to her husband, "Whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision."
Present/-

⇒ The lady ~~has~~ told her husband that whether he agreed with her or not she ~~would~~ not change her decision. ^{was}

⑨ The landlord ^{Past} said to the young man, "If you do ^{Present} not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."
Future.

⇒ The land lord ~~told~~ / warned the young man that if he did not pay his rent by evening that day he would have to leave the house immediately.

⑩ His wife ^{Past} said to him, "Do you ^{Present} know that my servant stole our money?"
Past

⇒ His wife asked him if he knew that her servant had stolen their money. ✓

⑪ Her friend ^{Past} said to her, "Can you ^{Present} spare your book for me for a week?"

⇒ Her friend asked her if she ~~could~~ spare her book requested ✓ for her for a week.
