a)

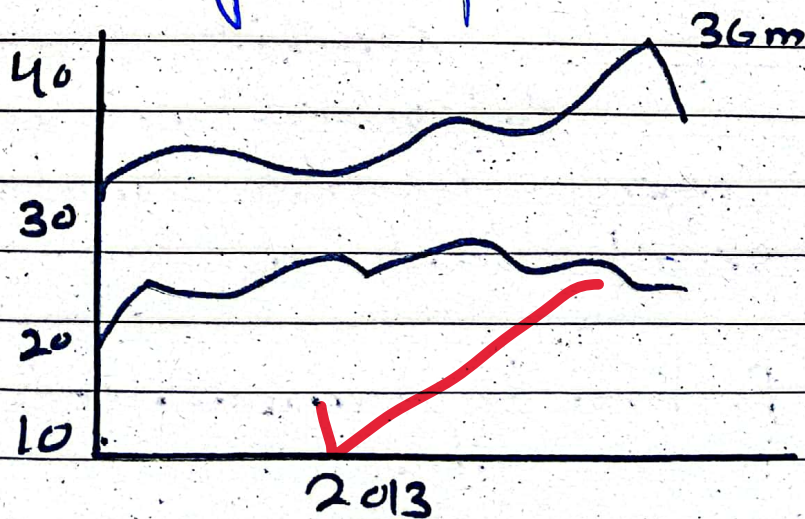
### Skyrocketing poverty

Therefore, population growth prevails social problems.

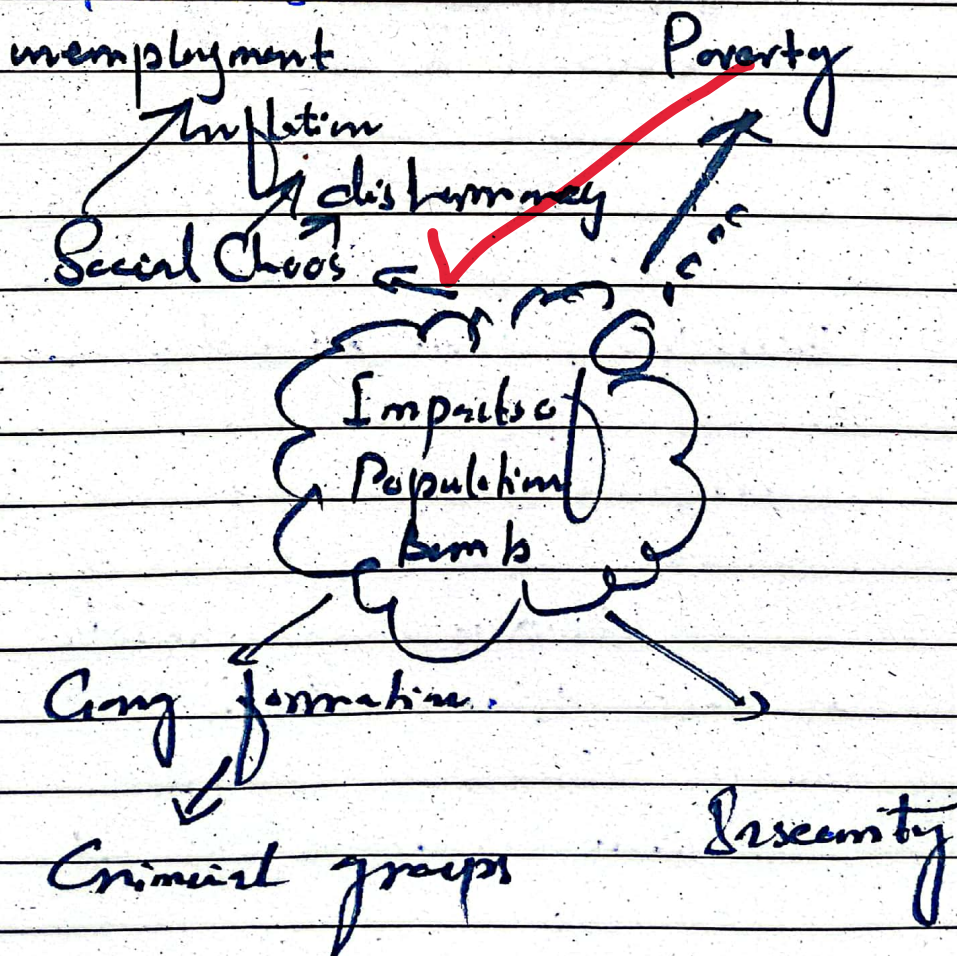
c)
