#### H. Socio-economic issues:

### K. Crime in the cyber space

Pakistan has been ranked seventh most vulnerable state by cyber-attacks in the world.

Criminal activities have shifted to cyber space because of the growing use of Android cellular phones and social media among youth of Pakistan. National Response Centre for cyber crime (NRC3) has established by Federal Investigation Agency to respond to the ever-increasing cyber crime. examples of cybercrimes include hacking, identity theft, digital privacy, banking frauds and spamming. According to FIA former director general **Dr. Sana Ullah Abbas**, 2,356 complaints pertaining to cyber crime were received by FIA in the year 2021. ~~Handly~~ ~~6000~~ ~~complaints~~ during the first quarter of 2022, DG FIA. Handling these criminal activities Criminology gives better understanding of cyber crime and its different modes in this regard. This aspect enhances the significance of criminology in Pakistan.

## L- Controlling White-collar Crime

Pakistan has been facing the challenge of white-collar crimes which has hindered the economic growth and development of the country. NAB's, 31 December 2018 white-collar crimes conviction hits 70%. The Express Tribune.

White-collar crimes are common in the country due to weak institutions and lack of checks by the established institutions for crime controlling. Knowledge of criminology can strengthen these institutions and can control white-collar crime.

## M- Juvenile Delinquency

Pakistan has high rate of juvenile delinquency. 22 million children are out of school in the country. Out of school children are more proven to become delinquent. Javed Jabbar (March 2021) in "Society: A childhood in prison" says that Pakistan has 1300 juvenile offenders in jails. These figure will be much higher presently.
