 - c) Pakistan has already (CoD) to eradicate military intervention - thus, Pakistan needs Charter of economy

- d) A healthy form of economy is needed to support free and fair election
- e) Weak and inefficient role of judiciary is an obstacle to economy - Pakistan needs Charter of economy to empower judiciary in order to protect public opinion

5- Charter of democracy leads to charter of economy (Synthesis)

- a) Democracy in the form of good governance leads to charter of economy
- b) Without charter of democracy, charter of economy can not resist the political polarization
- c) Pakistan still lacks the true charter of democracy - thus, needs CoD
- d) Free and fair election is the motive of CoD, not the CoE
- e) Real democracy empowers judiciary to protect public opinion, not the CoE
