INTRODUCTION:- National interest is the benefit that a state would decide to gain from creating a foreign policy.

DEFINITION:- Security, welfare, law and order, freedom, justice and ideology are the main reasons for a state's immediate existential survival, mid-term stability and long-term sustainability, is termed as national interest of a state.

IMPORTANCE:- The national interest is of vital role, in a state's development of relations with neighbour countries.

For example CPEC's plan is serving for both of the countries. As it would build a shortcut for the country, China, currently China is transporting about 60% of oil by Persian Gulf. While CPEC will provide a less distant and less costly way, Gawadar port.
