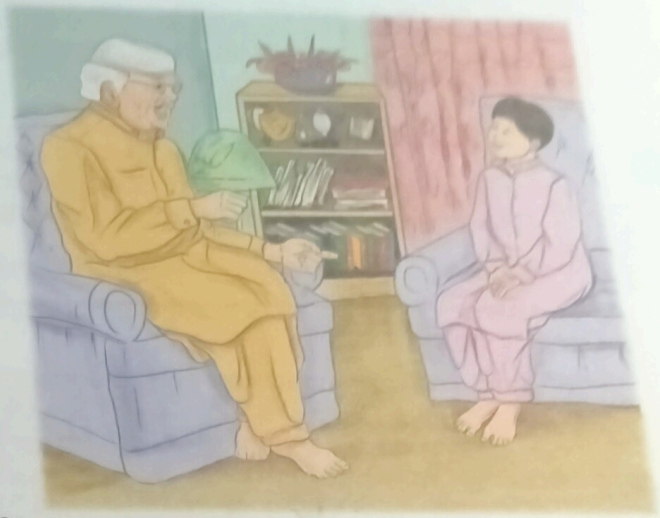


'What is wrong, Khizar?' asked Dada Jaan worriedly when he noticed that his grandson was frowning. Khizar repeated everything that he had read in the letter.
