Another major problem regarding Education is the lack of educational institutes for lower secondary and higher secondary students. Students cannot get education above primary in rural areas. According to Sindh Education Minister, "There are 40,000 schools in Sindh, out of which 36000 schools for primary students and only 4000 schools for lower secondary and higher secondary." When students want to get admission at 6 class, they find no educational institutes of lower secondary or higher secondary. No access to schools after primary education is also the most significant problem of education in Pakistan.
