Subheading: In order to increase its exports, Pakistan needs to improve its agriculture sector

And in order to increase its exports, Pakistan needs to improve its agriculture sector. The reason is that agriculture sector is the backbone of Pakistan's exports. History suggests that countries turned them from wheat importer states into wheat exporter nations just by investing in their agriculture sector. For example, Russia would import wheat from other countries in 1980s. However, after considering the potential of its agriculture sector, it started working on it. As a consequent, in 2017-18, it became the world's top wheat exporter by supplying 23 per cent of world exports of total wheat (William Liefert 'Russian agricultural trade and world markets', March 2020). In this way, like Russia, Pakistan, too, must make its agriculture sector better, so that it can reap its full potential.
