

Why juvenile system is not being implemented in Pakistan?

There are many reasons of juvenile system not being implemented in Pakistan, some of these reasons are discussed below

Establishment of observation homes:-

No observation home or rehabilitation centre yet been established in Pakistan for juvenile. This law makes it necessary upon police to place the juvenile in observation homes instead of police station but the law is being violated on non-availability of observation homes.

Out school children & labour child:-

Around 25 millions children in Pakistan are out of school at the age of school going. A huge number of children doing child labour. Child abuse are common in Pakistan, since state is not taking effective measures towards the rights of children, children are not figure

amongst top priorities of the state
so, juvenile law is being neglected
Overall attitude towards non-implemen-
-ation of laws:-

Pakistan is a country where
laws are in abundance on every
subject but these laws remains
restricted to book only, not being
implemented. The juvenile justice system
is not one of these, but there
are others laws too meet the
same fate. This indicates overall
non-implementation of law.

Civil society not aggressively pursuing
the children's rights:-

Some of civil society organizations
both domestic and international
are working on the right of children
However their presence is not felt
to such an extent to sensitize the
government about sensitivity of the
problem.

Role of media :-

Media is also not extending the coverage to sensitivity and gravity of the issue. The media doesn't playing a positive role on this issue to aware the general public to realize the issue of juvenile justice system,
