(6) Mental Health and Physical Health

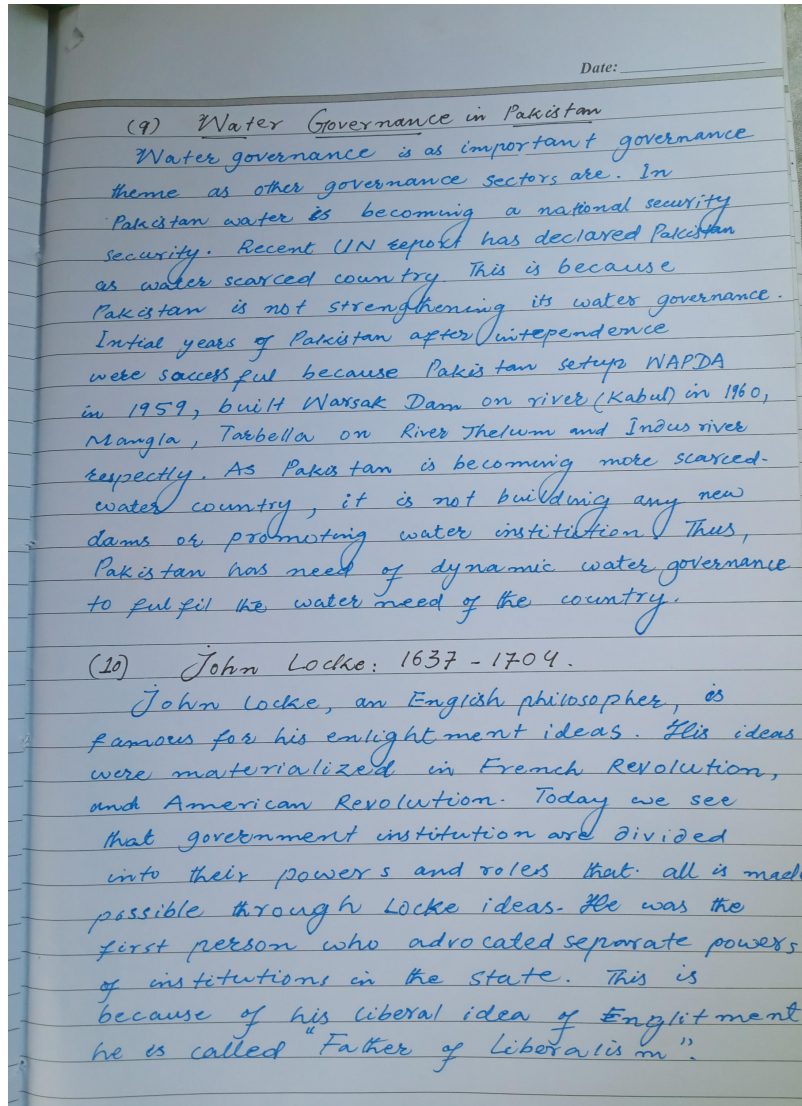
