Introduction

The world is global and countries are interlinked. In order to keep peace throughout the world - the organization needed. For this purpose, the first organization, League of Nations (LoN) was founded. But unfortunately, it failed in its mandate and this further led to the foundation of the United Nations (UN). Hence, the mandate of peace is going on through the UN.

League of Nations

League of Nations was founded in 1920. Its aim was to avoid wars between nations of the world and maintain peace throughout the world. The biggest reason behind formation/creation of LoN was outbreak of the World War I (WWI). Due to WWI, the world faced the greatest of devastations. To avoid such devastations in the future - Treaty of Versailles served a platform for officially ending of WWI. This treaty introduced the organization, LoN, to keep the world peaceful. Hence, LoN was founded. But with the course of time, LoN could not succeed in its aim and hence failed. In 1939, the

outbreak of the World War II (WWII) became failure of LoN. As LoN couldnot disarm Germany that led the greatest devastation in the world after WWI. Main reasons of failure of LoN was weak member structure and failure to disarm Germany. **Weak member structure** in the sense that the ^{most} powerful countries were never part of LoN or when they became part but delay. Germany became part after 6 years of foundation of LoN and USSR almost after 14 years. Moreover, the USA was never member of LoN whereas the US always advocated the organization in the world. **Failure to disarm Germany** also effected LoN - These reasons became failure of LoN. Hence, LoN was ended in 1946.

The United Nations

Main objective of United Nations (UN) was not different from the (LoN). The reason behind foundation of the (UN) was also to maintain peace and to avoid wars throughout the world. Before the UN, LoN was serving the same

fate, but unfortunately when LoN failed — the UN took its place. The outbreak of WWII and failure to disarm Germany ended LoN and foundation of the UN. It was founded on 24th October, 1946 whereas the LoN ended in 1946. Now, the UN serves the same purpose that was LoN serving — to maintain peace and to avoid wars.

UN is more successful than LoN

UN is the largest organization with 193 member countries. Though it has the same mandate as that of LoN yet it is the most powerful organization in the world. The success of UN is in its structure. It includes the most powerful countries such as Germany, Russia, the USA which were never earlier part of LoN. It means all these countries agreed to maintain peace throughout the world whether it would be economic or social. All countries have equal right to dissolve issues and to cast vote in order to keep the world safe from wars. Moreover, it has strong peace keeping mission to maintain peace internationally by collective army/military where it would lead

risk of international conflict.
Hence, UN is more successful
peace keeping body than LoN.
