Hence, due to its opportunities and challenges, the power of social media can be use more effectively.

Millions of people across the world uses several social media sites, such as Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Whatsapp, and many more. In this way, the power of social media brings comfortability and enhance connectivity.

Besides, oppostunities of the power of social media, it has put several

challenges to us. The following paragraphs will explain the challenges of social media emerging power in length.

The first challenge that is posed by the power of social media is that it is used as a tool for propaganda and sensationalism. Fake news spreads very quickly through this means. Politicians use it for their vested interest. For example, Donald James Trump used Facebook and Cambridge Analytica in order to win election in 2018. (Cambridge Analytica employee, Christopher Wylie, 2018). In the same way, it can be used to portray a false image of a state. For instance, India propagates fake news regarding the Kashmir issue through media. And the same is the case with the Israel-Palestine issue, where Israel uses media in their favor. No doubt, social media power is used as a tool for propaganda and sensationalism.

Likewise, the power of social media also presents a challenge in the shape of competition for breaking news. News channels, for the sake of increasing their channel ratings, they break news in such a way which may not be the case.

Different journalists represent their views and they ~~try~~ try to create sensationalism, which is also called yellow journalism. Take the example of ARY News and Geo news channels, both of them sometimes take sides in a political campaign. For instance, in general election 2018 of Pakistan, Ary openly supports PTI party, while Geo news backs PML(N) and other political rivals to PTI party. So, the competition for breaking news on social media is major challenge posed by the power of social media.

Moreover, spreading misinformation is another challenge emerge ^{by} from the power of social media. On social media, different sects in a religion tries to target each other views and thus it lead to the issue of sectarianism and extremism. Social media platform, as a matter of fact, is used for hate speeches by different communities and nations as well. Islamophobia is best example in this regard, as the western countries portrays the negative and hard image of Islam in the world. These kinds of misinformation can destroy the peace of the world. Hence, the spread of fake information through social media is a ~~major~~ major challenge

posed by the power of social media.

Furthermore, wastage of time due to excessive usage of social media is a great challenge not only for an individual but for the nation as well. Social media content are infinite and ^{after} every second after, it is updated and new piece of items are posted from ^{anywhere} everyone. So, its usage is a kind of addiction. Children, especially under 20 years of age, can largely wastes their huge time on to it. The prime example is Tik Tok, Snapchat, You-tube, Facebook, Instagram and so on. People of all ages waste their major time by frequent scrolling through these sites. Some people use social-media for almost more than 10 hours per day. And some even used smartphone more than 15 hours screentime without any reason. Hence, excessive usage of social media leads to wastage of time and is a challenge posed by the power of social media.

In addition to this, negative impacts on user health is another major challenge posed by the power of social media. As discussed in previous paragraph, that some users of social media spent about

more than 12 hours a day. Therefore, as a result, psychological impacts on the user occur. The user becomes its addict and he/she thinks about it everytime. It creates a sort of imaginary world in their mind. The user becomes less social and shy, especially, it can be observed in children. Also, excessive exposure to screens weakens their eye-sight. Additionally, memory loss also increases due to excessive use of digital app devices. Resultantly, it can be accepted that power of social media presents a challenge to the user health and fitness.

Lastly, threat of hacking is also a challenge created by the power of social media. The users of social media has an account and that accounts have access to an individual personal data. Therefore, there is always a threat of hacking that someone can theft secret information. The bank accounts in this regard ^{are} very sensitive. Famous celebrities, politicians and other personalities accounts can be easily attacked and hacked by the expert hackers. And thus, they are blackmailed as well in this manner. The cyber crimes, in fact, is not only limited to personal level but it is also presents in between the countries of the world as well. Thus, threat of hacking

is a major challenge originated by the power of social media.

Previous paragraphs discuss the challenges of power of social media. Now, the following paragraphs will discuss the way-forward to overcome the challenges of social media.

First of all, purification and filtering of the content is necessary to overcome the ^{negative} power of social media. For this, the regulator and controller of ^{respective} social media platform should filter out the real and correct content in an unbiased manner. Any content before releasing must be judge in a neutral and fair manner. Thus, filtering out filthy and fake content will improve the quality of social media platform upto maximum extent. For this purpose, a fine can also be imposed on ^{user by} giving false information. As a result, national interest as well as true content can be ^{secured} accessed. Therefore, purification and filtering of the content is sine qua non to overcome the challenge of misuse of social media.

Additionally, strict action over fake news ^{can} be taken to undermine the harsh challenge of social media.

These There should be an imposition of fine on the propagator. The fine should be so much that no one else could try to do such malaise act again. Likewise, Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority (PEMRA) rules should be applied over this medium as well. So, that ~~more~~ maximum people avoid fake news^{and} sensationalism. That is why, the challenge of negative impacts of social media can be minimize through strict action over fake news.

Apart from it, irregular usage of social media be avoided in order to reduce the bad impacts of social media power. There is, without any doubt, a need of awareness campaign in this regard. The common masses must understand the importance of their time. They should be educated in terms of social media usage. It is rightly advisable to use social media in free-time and in certain limitation. The personal and family life shall not^{be} affected from it. As it is said that, "Excess of anything is bad." Therefore, in order to overcome the harsh impacts of social media, its irregular usage must be avoided at any cost.

The last step to overcome the
