A head of the government must resign when he cannot serve his country in letter and spirit. If he quits his office, then his successor can perhaps serve the state in a better way than he is. Such person must consider the example of a head who resigned when he or she found it hard to efficiently govern the country. For example, the Prime Minister of New Zealand Jacinda Ardern resigned in 2023 after realizing that she was not steering her country towards the safer shores (Amanat Ali, 'A league of her own', January 2023). In short, a head of a government must resign from his post if he is unable to fulfill the requirements of his job.
