- 5- Good governance, all get ignored
- a) Abuse of (provincial) autonomy - leads political instability and national disintegration.

 - c) Only minor corruption is under control, while major is beyond control
 - d) Except a very small extent, human development is in crisis
 - e) Intelligence-based operations are unable to eradicate a threat of terrorism.
