He emphasized this issue that muslims are being irritated or annoyed. For instance, in India, headscarf girl was abused by social extremist group; similarly, in Norway, a Holy Quran was burnt. As a result, UN General Assembly unanimously adopted the resolution and declared 15 March as the International Day to combat Islamophobia on 15 March 2022; (UN press, General Assembly unanimously Adopts texts on Combating Islamophobia, March 2022). To summarize, Pakistan played pivotal role in combating Islamophobia.
