9. She manages her duties, without any help, despite her blindness. (Active)
Despite her blindness, her duties are managed by her, without any help.

10. I appreciate your efforts and hope you will continue in the same fashion. (Active)

Your efforts are appreciated by me and it was hoped that you will continue in the same fashion.

(Active)

7. The prisoners in Cuba are being treated cruelly, by the so-called Human Rights custodians. (Passive)

The Human Rights

The so-called Human Rights custodians are treating cruelly the prisoners in Cuba.

8. The present Government is serving the people honestly. (Active)

The people is being served honestly by the present Government.

9. Who did this? (Active)

This was done by whom? OR By whom this was done?

10. The Palestinians are avenging the death of their leaders. (Active)

The death of their leaders are being avenged by the Palestinians.
