which were present due to  
male bias.

Emergence of women studies as  
a discipline

women studies emerged as  
a subject in 1970s. Although  
the first course ~~of~~ on women  
studies started in 1868 in  
Cornell University.

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In 1970, the first program in women studies began at San Diego university. It was the time women studies were flourishing various programs on women studies were offered. The first scholarly journal on women studies Feminist studies published in 1972. In 1990 P.H.D was also offered in various universities. women studies led to the concept of gender studies.

when women as a concept expanded during late 1990s, people began to study of gender as a social construct. Initially ~~gender~~ the concept of gender started from feminist activism, but in the process it recognized how gender is socially constructed. The idea of men was also gendered, even men begin to look masculinity the way female were looking to femininity. which leads to the "men's studies and sexuality studies". moreover there was great interest ~~in~~ about the rights of transgenders, gay, and lesbian. These studies form the basis of gender studies.
