
2- US-India strategic partnership with respect to QUAD: An Overview



Indo-US Strategic partnership is mainly to contain China. However, it focuses on India's hegemony in the region.






Hence, Indo-US strategic partnership curtail China's growth.

Further, Indo-US partnership is also leading to 12U2 focus. In fact, increased paired partnership has put oxygen to partnership.




Hence, Indo-US partnership is enhancing.





6- Recommendations that Pakistan follow to curtail growing threats of Indo-US partnership


Following are measures:


