



It means internationalization of production and labour leading to integration of economies of developing and developed countries into global economy.) To quote Rosaberth M Kanter, "The world is becoming a global shopping mall in which ideas and products are available everywhere at the same time." Globalization is a natural outcome of computer networking and electronic mass

communication. Information technology has made it possible for nations of the world to contact one another beyond their national borders. Besides, globalization is also promoted through the growth and proliferation of multinational companies and corporations that operate as transporter networks. Anyhow the flow of capital technology and labour across the borders of countries has accentuated the process of
