Psychology of identity (gender psychology)

This field deals with human mind and functions, especially those affecting their behaviours in a given context. One school of thought commonly known as B. Psychoanalytic feminism focuses on how gender identity describes the individual's psychological perception of being male, female, neither both, or somewhere in between. This school of thought has its roots in Sigmund Freud's theory of psychoanalysis and Nancy Chodorow propounds this theory by arguing that gender identity is the result of complex development process. She believed that mothering promotes genders stereotype behaviour.
