a An account of the life and Services of Skah Wali Ullah: his contribution in saving the Indian Muslims from political annihilation and relegious degeneration Answer 1- Introduction Shah Wali Ullah, another descendent from the Family of Hazrat Umar Farcog - the second pious Caliph of Islam, proved sarious for the Indian Muslims who were facing political twomoil, social enstably, economic bankruptcy and seligious degeneration at that time. Being an original Islamic thinker, philosopher, mystic and scholar, he helped in segeneration of Indian Muslims by his political socio-economic and seligious se form movements. Thus, due to his exemplan contributions the Indian Muslims were not only able to confront the challenging situation posed by Indian non-muslims and foreign occupants but they also maintained their distinct identity 2- An account of his early life Shah Wali Ullah was born in 1704 m highly educated and religious family. His father what Abdur Rollin with well-know Islamic scholar and Fatawah e Alongon

Thus, the centuries old glory and grace of Muslim sule was about to dwindle with evident political annihilation of Indian Muslims and also their regions degeneration. They were divided into Shias and Sunni, euphentistically called as I sand and Turani and they were

at loggesheads over pity religious issues He tried to seek a common ground in various issues for the unity of Muslims Similarly, The also tried to present a balanced approach of four Islamic Schools of thoughts Hanafi, Malaki, Shayi and Hanbalis Therefoxe, he remained at the front to bridge the gaps among the Indian Muslims iii- Upgradation of Madrasa Rahimia Shah Wali Ullah upgraded the Madrasa Rahimia by updating its syllabus and making Sihah-e-Sittak integral part of syllabus for the first time Similarly, besides providing training platform for Islamic scholars, he made it as thinktank forum where new and emerging issues were used to be discussed and deliberated upon to seek new solutions and strategies to sayequard the ideologiv- Emphasis on Gitchad Shah Wali What emphasized to opt for Gitchad instead of

was his letter which motivated is Ahmad Shah Abdali, King of Afghanistan, to help Muslims in the Battle of Panipat in 1767 6- Socio-economic Contributions of Shah Wali Ullah According to Shah Wal Ullah, just socio-economic order acts às backbone for the political stability and seligious harmony. Therefore, leing authority on the Islamic economic system, he emphasized overwhelmingly on equitable and low Laxation system, provision of economic oppostunities inespective of social status Similarly, he discussed the causes of turmoit in his book Hajjal-al-Baligha. He also emphasized on the protection of basic human rights. 5- Outcomes of the Contributions of Shah Wali Ullah Unlike other theoratical thinkers . Shah Wali Ullah was realist and practical redeemer, who had fully realized the political estimeconomic and

seligious conditions of Indian Muslims and the needs of the time. Therefore his contributions for the Indian Muslims in seligious and pritical spheres brought long-Pasting impacts. After his death, This illustrious sons Shah Abdul App and Shah Abdul gadest carried forward the legacy of Shak Wali Ullak Later on their brilliant disciples and students kept theis beacon alive Serving Indian Muslims and safeguarding their ideological frontiers. Shah Ahmal Shaheed, Maulana Abdul Hai and Shah Ismail Shaheed are few of these outstanding ones.
