Social learning theory belongs to modern and positivist school of thoughts which are based on to demonstrate root cause of criminality. It has been started since mid of seventeen century.


Many psychologists and criminologists add to invent this theory. Albert Bandura said, "An individual observes what is going on around me then adopt that thing in his own behavior".
