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Q: Write a comprehensive note on autonomy vs. Integration debate in gender studies.

INTRODUCTION:-

1) WOMEN-ORIENTED ~~and~~ STUDY:-

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4) ENABLE ONE TO UNDERSTAND ALL GENDERS:-

As a separate field of study, the advocates of autonomy believe that the student of Gender Studies would ~~not~~ be able to understand the problems of all genders, as the focus would be solely be on their ~~problem~~ issues.

5) INCREASE RESEARCH:-

As a separate field, it would encourage ~~the~~ the participants to ~~other~~ acquire more knowledge about the history ~~of~~, experiences and issues faced by women, thereby encouraging research in solving those problems.

6) INTEGRATION WILL PUT A CONSTRAINT ON EQUALITY:-

Incorporating with other fields will hinder equality, that lead to the ~~of~~ very base of this subject. The basis of this subject was put forward in the name of the 2nd Wave of Feminism, therefore if it remains very close to the sentiments of activists. The advocates of "separation" believe that equality will thrive if the issue is given autonomous ~~#~~ status.

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VIEWPOINT OF THE "INTEGRATIONISTS": HAIR (P)

The belief of the integrationists is to integrate the field of gender studies in other subjects, rather than a separable subject.

1) GREATER OUTREACH:-

The proponents of integration debate put forward a point that integrating ~~the~~ gender studies into another field of study will make it easier for other people to access and understand the problems faced by women & minorities.

2) BEST WAY TO COMPEL POLICYMAKERS:-

Best way to convince ~~polym~~ policymakers to ~~not~~ keep gender studies in mind while formulating laws is to incorporate the subject with other major disciplines, is an oft-argument by the proponents of integration debate.

3) HELP STUDENTS CHOOSE G.S FOR HIGHER STUDIES

Studying gender studies along with other subjects will help students to pursue it further ~~to~~ to do a Masters, M.Phil or PhD in the subject.

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4) PAVES WAY FOR BIG CHANGES:-

By integrating gender studies with other major disciplines, more awareness can be brought about, thereby making big changes in the field of gender studies and gender-related issues.

5) INTEGRATING MEANS INTEGRATING INTO THE SOCIAL FABRIC :-

Integrating ~~gender~~ women in school in the spheres of social, cultural, economical political fields means treating them as ~~sex~~ entities in the society, thereby integrating them, not only at the level of study but in society too.

6) SENSITISING MASSES ABOUT GENDER DISCRIMINATION:-

Due to long history of denial of women's rights and dichotomising men and women into gender roles, most people have become desensitised to gender-bias. Integrating gender studies with fields might bring out the solution to that.

CONCLUSION:-

The debates put forward by both the streams of thought present strong points. It should be studied from the ground up in order to help eliminate the issues faced by women in society. It can not only
