The male follow the rules devised by the governments in the working area.

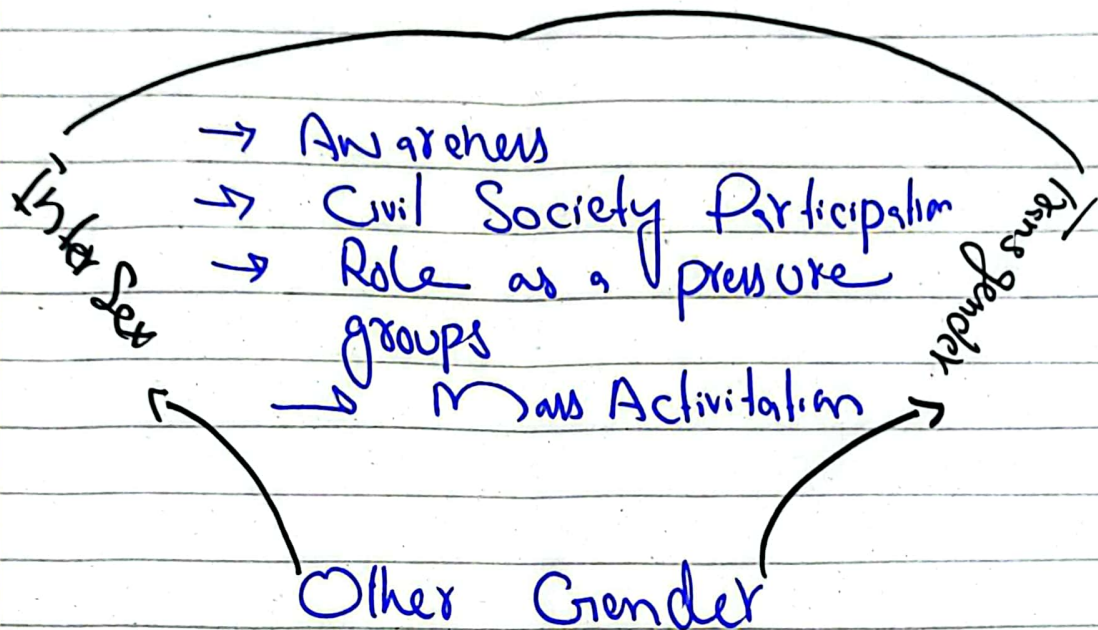
(b) - Devising the Environmental friendly rules in the national and international level
