Sub-heading: Nuclear challenge to world peace during 21st cent

Supporting Point: To make sure the peace of the world in 21st century, the Fifth Review Conference (RevCon) of the parties to the Treaty on Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT) met from 1 to 26 August 2022 in New York.

Evidence: In 2019, 189 incidents were reported by 36 states, indicating that unauthorized activities and events involving nuclear and other radioactive materials, including incidents of trafficking and malicious use, continue to occur (IAEA, 2020).
