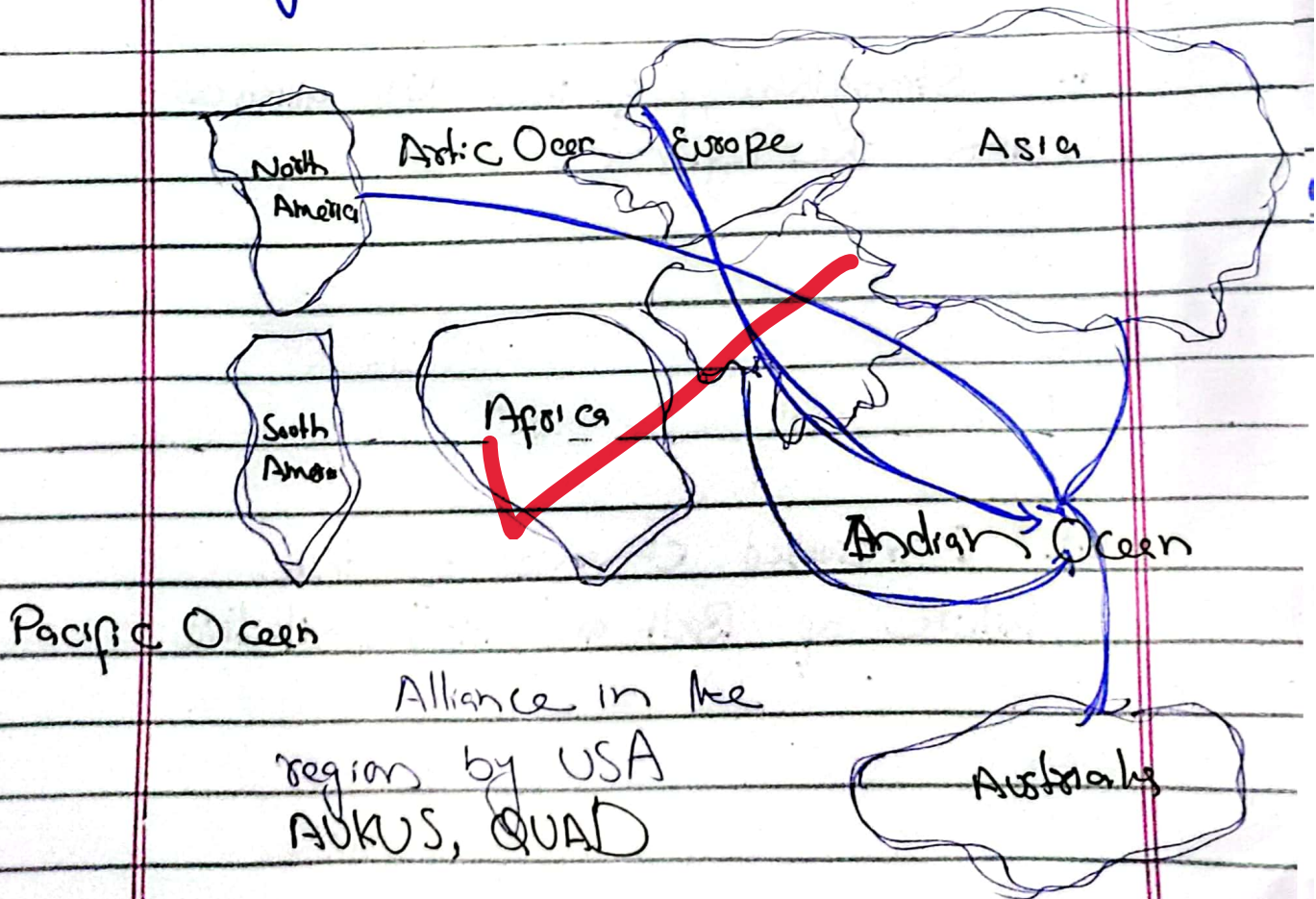
4.3 - Threat of the ~~chances~~ war between China and USA
