As Allah says in Quran, "And your God is one God. There is no deity (worthy of worship) except Him." (Al-Quran, 33:44). This is the basic tenet to which prophet (SAW) asked humanity to adhere. One can't be a muslim if one does not believe in the oneness of Allah and one who associates someone with Allah in person, attributes, and actions is called mushrik. So, belief in the oneness of God is called Tauheed which is the core pillar and gateway to enter into Islam.

2.2. PROPHETHOOD: Belief in prophets is one of core belief of Islam. Allah sent His prophets for the guidance of human beings to live their lives according to the will of their Lord. Prophet Muhammad (SAW) sealed this long line of prophets and was sent to the whole humanity and his teachings are considered as complete, universal and eternal.

As Allah says in one of many verses of Quran, "Muhammad is not the father of any of your men, but he is the messenger of Allah and the seal of the prophets and Allah has full knowledge of all things." (33:41). Anyone who is not believing in the finality of prophet Muhammad (SAW) is not considered as a muslim.
