Ans:- Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) is Rahmet-ul-lil-Alameen for the entire world. He possessed high morals, sublime character and acknowledged by Almighty in the Quran (Al-Quran). His personality was a blend of grace, sympathy and merciful to the creatures of Almighty. He was considered the best model for an individual to get insight from his life. The prophet Muhammad (pbuh) embodies myriads of features, which are given below.

(1) Truthful and Honest:-

The pagans of Makkah used to call him as truthful and honest person. They used to resolve conflicts on Muhammad's decisions and used to keep their commodities and luggage (amanah) with him. When he started preaching Islam in Makkah, they turned their faces and started calling him wizard as well as ousted from Makkah.

(2) Kind Father!

Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) a kind father. He used to stand when Fatimah (R.A) visited him, and kissed her forehead gently. It reflects the sign of being kind and

lovable to own children. Moreover, he considered Zaid bin Haritha as a genuine son, though he was a fostered son. In Arab world, it wasn't allowed to keep the foster son and treat him like a real son. The prophet Muhammad (SAW) was about giving him part in his inheritance, but Almighty sent verses from Quran to not do that. This depicts that he was kind towards his ^{own} children as well as his foster child.

A loving Grandfather:-

Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) was a loving grandfather to his children named Hassan and Hussain. He used to ride them on his shoulders or back.

④ Ideal Husband:-

Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) had a very kind towards his wives. Being a diplomat, a military strategist, a judge - in his hectic schedule

he used to give time to his wives. He had scheduled time between Asr and Maghrib to visit his wives. He was ever smiling personality. When the religion burdened increased on him - Almighty said to him if he could divorce his wives, he can - but the wives denied despite his hectic schedule, though he was kind to him. Hazrat Khadija (R.A) said - that they used to survive for two months on dates and water only. Prophet Muhammad (Pbuh) was liberal in his house, and used to say "Assalam-u-Alaikum" when he entered home.

Once Hazrat Umar (R.A) visited prophet Muhammad (Pbuh). Hazrat Umar knocked the door, and heard overvoiced of prophet's wives. The prophet (SAW) opened the door and sat him in his house. This reflects that he calmly endured his internal conflicts and issues.

(5) Friendly Father-in-law:-

He was very friendly by nature. Once Hazrat Fatima (R.A) visited Muhammad (Pbuh) house. She was worried because she and Ali (R.A) quarrelled with each other. The prophet Muhammad (Pbuh) sensed the situation and visited the mosque to seek Ali (R.A). He was there ~~being~~ laid on the ground.

The prophet called him Abu-Turab and bring him home to resolve the issue. Such of nature was Muhammad (pbuh) with his son-in-law. He didn't blame anyone, but emphasized on resolving the conflict on smiley face.

⑥ A Perfect Friend:

Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) was very close to his friends. He has scheduled the meeting with them right after Ishaq prayer (After Fajar). He used to listen their stories and on-going issues in their lives. He used to accept the gifts and Fidya from his friends with open hearts.

⑦ Grateful and Patient:

Prophet Muhammad practiced gratitude in his life. He used to say "Jazak Allah" to the people in returned of favours or good. Prophet Muhammad said - Those who doesn't practice gratitude towards Allah is well. (Hadith) Prophet Muhammad experienced brutality and exploitation from Makkah. But he remained silent and calm. All he endured and compromised because of Islam.

He was ousted from Makkah. They used to plan his murder along with his companions. but they ~~would not~~ ^{would not} succeed.

prophet Muhammad (pbuh) said - No one has ever endured ^{hard-ship} as I - in the path of Islam (Hadith)

After the demise of Hazrat Khadija and Abdul-Muttalib. He ~~was~~ ^{heart} broken and sorrowful. So he ~~visited~~ ^{visited} Taif. he planned to preach in Taif because they were known for the hospitality and open-hearted. In Makkah, he didn't have proper support after the demise of Abdul-Muttalib. Taif treated him very badly, throw stones ~~towards~~ on him. Hazrat Muhammad (pbuh) bled but remained silent and calm.

⑧ A Considerate Neighbour

- Those who doesn't treat well with the neighbours - will not go to jannah (Al-Hadith)

- prophet Muhammad said - jibrael frequently visited regarding neighbour rights that they should be ~~to~~ ^{to} treated kind and polite. ~~and~~

Abu-Zar (R.A) said that the prophet Muhammad (pbuh) said to me that add water in broth ~~and~~ share it with your neighbours (Al-Hadith)

This reflects that Islam is very concerned regarding the treatment (humanely) with the neighbours.

⑨ A Caring Human Being:-

Harat Muhammad (pbuh) treated his foster son very kindly and considered as his own/genuine son. It wasn't a trend in Arab to respect or be kind to his foster son.

Prophet Muhammad (SAW) used to sit with slaves and ate with them on several occasions.

Prophet Muhammad said: No one of you becomes a true believer unless he likes for his slaves what he likes for himself. (Al-Hadith).

(10) Care of his Hygiene | Hygiene

Prophet Muhammad used to wear clean clothes. His favourite colour was white colour. He used to do Miswak, oiling and combing his hair and beard on daily basis. Purity is half of the faith. (Al-Hadith)

(11) A Balanced Personality:-

Prophet Muhammad was a devoted worshipper, a military strategist,

diplomat and judge at the same time.
He was a family guy - very concerned
about his family. He spent time
on daily basis in his hectic schedules
and routine. He was a true
friend - a friend that is used
in dire need of time. Furthermore,
he was a perfect preacher, despite
the unbearable hardships and
complexities - he truly convey the
Almighty Allah message towards
the people (His creature).
