Introduction:

Islam is complete code of life. It's system of zakat is comprehensive. The literal meaning of zakat is nourishment of both body and health, it purifies the heart from materialism. Zakat made obligatory on 2.A.H. It is most prescribed obligation after salat. Quran mention zakat more than eighty times. It has social, moral and spiritual impacts and discussed in following text-

Obligation of Zakat in

Quran:

انما الصدقات للفقراء والمساكين والعالمين
عليهم والموءلفة القلوب وفي الرقاب والغارمين
وفي سبيل الله وبن سبيل فرينة من الله
والله اعلم بالحقم

(البقره - 60)

Zakat is collection is only for
needy and indigent and those who
employed for its collections; and
for those whose hearts are to be win over;

Rules for Zakat

(i) Zakat is obligatory only on muslim
with complete nisab

(ii) It can only be given to muslim and
not for tribe of Banu-Hashim

(iii) It cannot be given to slaves for their
services, wives, kids or other relatives

(iv) It is not essential for personal use
articles and camels for personal
transportation.

(vii) It cannot be given to person who possesses
nisab or debtor is exempted from zakat

Gold	7.5 tola
Silver	52.5 tola
Camel	1
Cows	30
Sheep/goats	40
buried wealth	5%
Ushus	10% on rainy land
Trade articles	2.5%
Kharrrs	5% on irrigation land

Elimination Of Social Classes

Karl Marx in his book "A Manifest Destiny" says, "the class differences in a society are man made and due to unequal distribution of wealth". In such way zakat helps to eliminate the social classes

ii) Increase The Mutual Care

And Respect: The mutual care and respect is essential for a progressive society. Zakat develop the system of mutual care by giving own wealth to others to care and support them.

(iii) It Strengthen The National Economy:

Zakat strengthen the national economy by exchanging the capital in all hands of society. So people don't involve in hoarding but utilize their money

° Prophet (PBUH) said on one occasion
"Whoever made wealthy and doesn't pay Zakat, his wealth turn to a snake on day of resurrection enircle his neck and say I'm your wealth while biting his cheeks"
Such stories inspire people to pay Zakat to poor people which decrease their poverty. Also, it prevent them to involve in unlawful earning so prevent crime in society.

(v) Eradicate Immoral Practices

Immoral Practices such as prostitution is due to unequal wealth distribution. If they get enough money in form of Zakat they would not indulge in such immoral practices

SPIRITUAL IMPACTS

(ii) Satisfaction By Helping Others,

As Allah says in the Quran,

Indeed who believe, and do righteous deeds, offer prayer, and pay Zakat, will have their reward with Allah (الْبِئْرُ)

As Allah has promised for the reward, people find hearty satisfaction by helping others in form of Zakat

(iii) Remove Love of Materialism,

When a person give from their own wealth it remove the love from his wealth about materialism. He remain no more a materialistic man but become pious.

(iii) Closeness to Allah

This world is a place of continuous test and assessment for human.

By giving wealth, a man's heart become far away from this world's wealth. He finds peace because of this financial Jhadah and become close to Allah.

(iv) Sacrificing - the Beloved Things for Allah makes man Pious.

MORAL IMPACTS

Allah's trust is crucial for a muslim and prophet (PBUH) says "Zakat increase one's wealth, it does not decrease it". Which mean when a person giving Zakat he has trust on Allah that in this way he will not lose his wealth thus it increase the trust on his Sustained.

(iv) It rises Humanitarian Spirit,

Zakat rises humanitarian spirit in a muslim's heart and increase his level of moral as prophet (PBUH) said: "Do not envy anyone only the one who has given wealth and spent it continuously in the path of Allah"
