Title Rational and Political Poet

Rationale of poetry is to address masses in abstract form. On the contrary, there is a kind of poetry which is highly subjective. First type of poet deals with public themes and he may be affected by contemporary events at some point. Poet shares his version by which millions of others may relate themselves with the poet. This is what Shakespeare did. But the political poet does not construct imaginary past. Rather he tries to point vast present. The gap between poet and his subject is unbridgeable. Distinction between what matters and what not has to be drawn. He may see a huge event which possibly does not matter for others at all. Political poet keeps himself in dark and tries to diversify present which matters to others.
