## Global Food Crisis:-

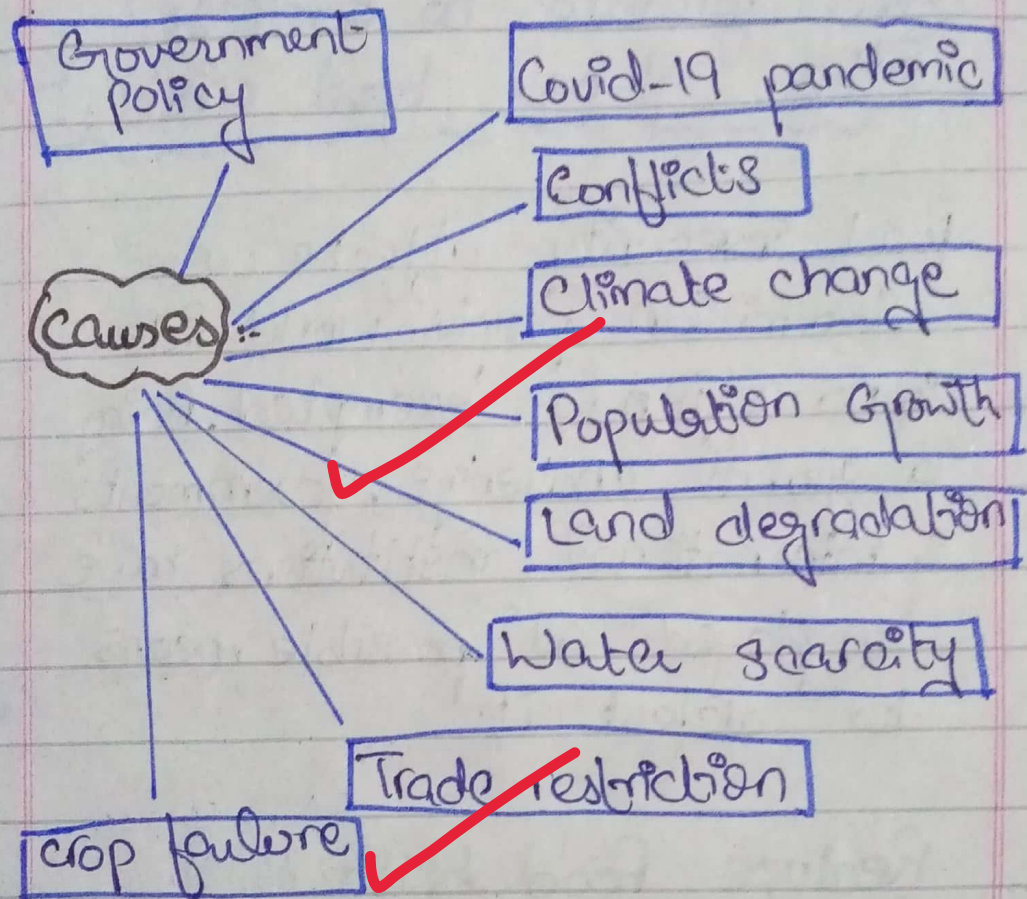

Way forward to address the global food crisis :-

Food insecurity affects over 820 million people worldwide & no region is exempted. Being a global challenge, governments & international institutions have employed ~~all~~ possible means to defeat it.

### 1. Reduce Food Waste :-

Food is wasted mainly because of inefficient preparation, poor road structures, over-selective customers, inadequate storage facilities.

If food storage facilities are improved, and ~~there~~ are adequate preparation on how food will be used,

less food will be wasted, & there will be a more food-secure community.

FAO reports that each year, the food wasted globally is about 1.3bn tonnes.

## 2- Reduce the Risk of Commercialising:-

If food is grown for the purpose of feeding the community a nation, food insecurity levels will go down. Farmers can produce more food crops & later on cash crops when there are enough food crops in the market.

There will be less risk of commercialization of food if it is sufficient in the market. Governments should also implement programs allowing farmers to know when there is sufficient food for everyone.

" In a 2022 article for the Economist, the author argued that the global food system is "broken" & that it needs to be transformed in order to feed the world's growing population.

The author called for a no of reforms, including investing in sustainable agriculture, reducing food waste & improving access to food for the poor.

### 3. Improve Existing Infra-structural Programs.

Some farmers fails to get their production to market because of poor infrastructure and food processing equipments.

Technology can play a role in improving food security by increasing agricultural productivity, improving food distribution. It helps farmer to reduce pesticides & fertilizers.

The use of blockchain technology can help to improve food traceability and reduce food fraud.

#### 4. Improve Trade Policies:-

Unfair trade policies in the market is another cause of food insecurity crisis. Corporate giants have stepped in & commercialized food, making it difficult for small scale farmer to take their feed to market. Resilient supply chain.

#### 5. Promote Diversification:-

Focussing on a single food crops or staple can lead to terrible outcomes in adding food insecurity. To improve food security, there needs to be training on the importance of diversified and healthy diets for better nutrition.

## 6- Close the Yield Gap:-

Most of the our farming lands are drained of their natural fertility levels and cannot produce as much as they did years ago.

To close the gap, governments and agricultural institutions have developed strategies and programs for improving crop yield, especially location-specific methods of sustainable agricultural intensification such as soil management & land improvement.
