The Tehreek Taliban Pakistan (TTP) organised in 1979 by Pakistan. The reason behind creation of TTP is opposed to Soviet Union (USSR) till elimination from Afghan region. The control in Afghan land Pakistan feels threat to occurrence of USSR influence due to its strategic importance. But Pakistan denied their interconnection with TTP growth and support through foreign intelligence agencies. Further Pakistan divided Taliban in two categories The good Taliban and bad Taliban. The group which harm Pakistan considered as bad Taliban (TTP).

Impact on trade

Afghanistan blames Pakistan for imposing the Taliban and oppressing them. Despite challenges Pakistan prior trading with Afghanistan. because Afghanistan is one of major importer of Pakistan. Pakistan strength of economy
